OCTOBER BLOCK

Block Instructions

October Block

Make 2 blocks.

Fabric: Background	(2) 8½ x 8½"
Kimberbell® Stabilizer*	
Fusible Backing • Iron to the wrong side of the Background Fabric.	

*Additional stabilizers are listed below.



Embroidery File

5x7-october

5x7: 4.00 x 6.50" or
101.6 x 165.1 mm

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This project was made with Glide thread from Hab+Dash® by Fil-Tec®.

*Needed only for optional block-by-block quilting.

Quilting Options

Option 1: Block-by-Block Quilting

- Hoop the **Light Mesh Cut-Away** stabilizer only.

Design

A kdq667-christmas-17, 6x6 design
6.50 x 6.50" or 165.1 x 165.1 mm

Centered Alignment:

- Center the block file with the quilting file.
- Refer to the "Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)" section in the **Guide**.
- After quilting, go to the Embroidery Instructions.



Option 2: Traditional Quilting

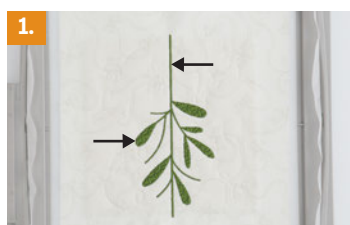

Traditional Hooping:

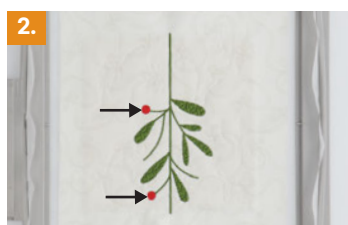
- Mark the **center** of the Background Fabric.
- Cut the **Medium Cut-Away** stabilizer larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Tape the fabric to the **center** of the stabilizer.
- Hoop the stabilizer and fabric with the **center** mark in the **center** of the hoop.
- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Go to the Embroidery Instructions.

Note: The photos in these instructions feature the Block-by-Block Quilting Method. Use these instructions for both hooping options.

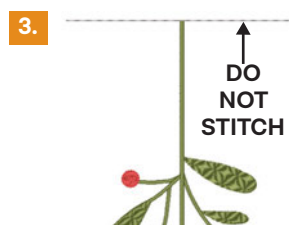
Embroidery Instructions



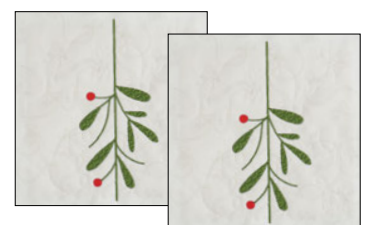
I Stitch the Stems and Leaves Fills.



M Stitch the Berries Fills.



Do not stitch this step.
This stitch is for design placement only.



• Remove the block from the hoop. Repeat these instructions to make a total of **(2)** blocks.

Trimming Instructions



Special Trimming Instructions (Refer to the **Guide**.)

• Place a 6½ x 6½" Orange Pop Ruler over the block.

- ⚠ • Align the **center stem exactly** with the **center arrows** on the ruler and square the block to 6½ x 6½".

Note: The Beads, Premade Bow, and Rickrack Trim will be added later, in the last month of the project.



Filler Block Instructions

Optional Block-by-Block Quilting

Filler Blocks 12 and 21

Make 1 of each filler block.

Fabric 1: Filler Block 12	(1) 3 x 13"
Fabric 2: Filler Block 21	(1) 3 x 11"
Kimberbell® Stabilizer	
Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer	
Project Batting	
Fusible Backing	
 Iron to the wrong side of both fabric pieces.

Quilting Instructions

For more information on quilting the filler blocks, refer to the "Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)" section in the **Guide**. Use the following quilting designs.

Filler Block	Quilting Design	Embroidery Field
K Block 12	kdq667-christmas-17, 2x12 design	2.50 x 12.50" or 63.5 x 317.5 mm
K Block 21	kdq667-christmas-17, 2x10 design	2.50 x 10.50" or 63.5 x 266.7 mm

2x10 design



After quilting, trim each quilted filler block to the Standard Size listed below.

Filler Block	Trim to Standard Size
Block 12	2½ x 12½"
Block 21	2½ x 10½"
