

Let's Start Quilting Supply List & Agenda
Bring this paper to class – All supplies are available at Red-Roxy Quilt Co.

Book – Start Quilting with Alex (free with class). Read pages 4 – 21 before class.

Rail fence block as a table runner (alternative pattern will be available at the first class)

Fabric (15% class discount)

Light Color (Block) – ¼ yard

Medium Color (Block) – ¼ yard

Dark Color (Block) – ¼ yard

Dark Color (border, binding) – 5/8 yard

Backing 5/8 yard

Thread

Color to match light color (piecing and quilting), suggest Aurifil cotton thread

Color to match dark color (quilting) – you can purchase later

Batting (15% class discount)

Craft Size (46" x 36") (Quilter's Dream Cotton Batting is recommended)

(Polyester batting is not recommended for this project)

505 Basting Spray (15% class discount)

Small Can

Sewing Machine in good working order (foot control & cord)

Quarter inch foot or utility foot

Walking foot if you have one

Pins

Suggest a fine pin for piecing (Blue Clover or Glass Head or Magic Pins (.5mm))

Fabric Marker – Can get at the time we do the quilting. (15% class discount on one marker)

Suggest Chaco Marker - White

Hand sewing needle

Suggest Chenille Needles – easy threading

Seam Ripper

Small scissors for snipping threads

Optional for class but you will want for your future quilting projects:

Mat (suggested size 18" x 24")

Rotary Cutter (suggested 45 mm either Ergonomic or Splash) – Definitely bring to class if you have a rotary cutter.

Cutting Ruler (suggested size 6.5 x 24.5)

Lunch – We will not do an official break for lunch for day long class. Brown bag is suggested.

Agenda for 3 full day classes (evening agenda is varied due to shortened class time)

Class 1-Introduction – tools, fabric selection, cutting, sewing ¼ inch seams

Cut Fabric

Sew strips

Cut Squares

Class 2 Pin & sew together blocks

Apply borders

Start Quilting

Class 3 Finish Quilting

Binding – will be hand sewn down
