
(X) CUT SQUARE IN HALF TWICE DIAGONALLY TO YEILD 4 TRIANGLES

LIGHT -
$$A - (8) 2$$
" $\times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " ASSORTED DARKS - $B - (4-8*) 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " sq. (X)

*Only (2) B squares are required for this block. Cut more for a scrappier look.

ASSEMBLY

- 1. Layer B-assorted dark triangles over each of the A-light rectangles, right sides up with long sides aligning; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Make (8) flying geese units.
- 2. Lay out flying geese in pairs; sew pairs together. Sew block together in rows; press seams open.
- Make (1) Dutchman's Puzzle block that measures 6 ½" square.
