Crosswalk

35" square charm quilt by Kansas Troubles Quilters

I loved playing with the brighter palette of Vanessa's Lollipop Garden fabric collection to create a table topper perfect for spring decorating. Her fabrics coordinated beautifully with many of my vintage Easter collectibles. I also made a second quilt in my KT Favorites III fabric, just for fun.

SUPPLIES	BRIGHT	KTQ	
Blocks - A,B	(1) Charm Pack	(1) Charm Pack	
Background-C	White - fat 1/4	Tan - fat 1/4	
Sashing - E	Stripe - ½ yd.	Tan - ½ yd.	
Border, Binding, D	Green - ¾ yd.	Navy- ¾ yd.	

CUTTING

(/) = cut square in half once diagonally to yield 2 triangles

Charm Squares

(27) medium/dark A - (18) 5" sq. (/) B - (9) charm squares cut into (4) 2 ½" sq. each

White Print or Tan Print

Background - C - (36) 2 1/8" sq. (/)

White w/green stripe or Tan Print

Sashing - E - (84) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Green or Navy

Corner post - D - (49) 1 ½" sq.


Border - (4) 1 ½" x WOF


Binding - (4) 2 ½" x WOF

Assembly


Fabrics for bright quilt are listed first, with KT fabric in parenthesis.

- 1. Sew a C-white print (tan print) triangle on two sides of each B-square; press toward C.
- 2. Add A-medium (dark) triangle to B/C unit; press toward A. Trim block to 4 ½ square.
- 3. Mix or match A-triangles with (4) matching B-squares for each block. Sew blocks, E-sashing strips and D-sashing posts together; press toward sashing and sashing posts, as shown. Make (9) blocks that measure 9 ½" square.





Make 4 each.





Make 9 blocks.

- 4. Lay out blocks 3x3 along with sashing strips and sashing posts, as shown in quilt diagram. Sew quilt center together in rows; press toward sashing strips. Center of quilt measures 31 ½" square.
- 5. Trim (2) 2 ½" outer border strips to measured length of quilt center (31 ½"). Pin and sew to opposite sides of quilt; press toward outer border. Trim (2) 2 ½" outer border strips to measured width of quilt top and bottom (35 ½"). Pin and sew to top and bottom of quilt; press toward outer border. Quilt measures 35 ½" square.

Finishing - Sandwich quilt top, batting and backing. Machine quilt as desired. Bind with 2 ½" double binding pieced to at least 156" long.
