## SUPPLIES

KTQ Jelly Rolls (JR) - (40) $21 / 2 \prime$ x WOF strips - about (30) darks/(10) tans
Gold- sashing
2

Black - border \& binding
$83^{\prime \prime} \times 90^{\prime \prime}$
$17 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$.
$21 / 4 \mathrm{yds}$. 5 yds.

Cotton Thread - dark tan

## CUTTING

(32) Dark Jelly Roll strips (Use more dark JR strips for a scrappier look.)

Cut a total of: C - (64) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

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\begin{aligned}
& \text { D - (128) } 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \\
& \text { E - (64) } 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \text { sq. }

From each dark JR strip, cut (2) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, (4) $4 \frac{112 \prime \prime}{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments, as shown.

(18) Tan Jelly Roll strips

Cut a total of: A - (64) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

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\text { B - (128) } 21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \text { sq. }

From each $\tan$ JR strip, cut (4) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments, as shown.


Gowd - sashing - lap - (7) $3^{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ LOF

BLACK - outer border - (4) $71 / 2 "$ x 80 "LOF binding - (5) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 80^{\prime \prime}$ LOF

## Jelly Roll Assembly

Sew an E-dark to an A-tan. Make 64.


Sew a D-dark to a B-tan. Make 128.


## Unit \#1

Layout A, B and C segments as shown. Piece segments to create Unit \#1; press seams up. Make (32) Unit \#1 that measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## Unit \#2

Layout A, B and C segments as shown. Piece to make Unit \#2; press seams down. Make (32) Unit \#2 that measure $611 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## Unit \#3

Sew Unit \#1 to Unit \#2 with lights together to create Unit \#3; wait to press. Make (32) Unit \#3.


Measurements for length of rows, sashing and borders are given as a guide only; measure your quilt.

## Pieced Rows

Layout (8) Unit \#3's in a vertical row ; press seams as indicated by arrows in placement diagram on next page. Piece (4) rows that measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Sashing

Measure your rows. Cut (5) sashing strips to length ( $641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ). Alternate sashing strips and pieced rows so that sashing strips are between rows and on each side; press toward sashing strips. Measure quilt top from side to side ( $631 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ). Trim (2) sashing strips to length. Add to top and bottom of quilt top; press.

## Outer Border

Measure your quilt top. Trim side outer borders to length ( $701 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ ). Sew to sides of quilt top; press toward outer borders. Repeat for top and bottom outer borders ( 77 ½").

SANDWICH quilt top, batting and backing using the method of your choice.

Machine Quilt in-the-ditch between rows and sashings; "X" thru squares and rectangles; crosshatch outer border. Trim batting and backing. Bind with double $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide binding and pieced end-to-end with mitered seams to at least $334^{\prime \prime}$ long.
top \& bottom sashing - $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
