# Star Cluster by Kansas Troubles Quilters 

## Corrections

Here are a few corrections we found for the first printing of our Star Cluster pattern.

## Page \#8

Section \#1 - Small HST
(8) darks - HST - (1 each) $23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ sq.
(8) tans - HST - (1 each) $23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ sq.

Piece (16) assorted HST; trim to 2" square. Layout out HST in (2) rows of (8) HST each. Sew blocks together in rows; press seams open. Sew rows together; press. Small HST section measures $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ".

Sections \#2 \& 3 - Large HST
(8) darks - HST - (1) 3 3/8" sq.
(8) tans - HST - (1) $3 \frac{3}{8}{ }^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{sq}$.

Piece (15) assorted HST; trim to $3^{\prime \prime}$ square.
TIP: I like to cut my squares for HST $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ larger and trim to size.
For small HST, cut $21^{1 / 2}$ squares. For Large HST, cut $31^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ squares.

## Page \#10

Tan \#2 - 2nd border
Cut (6) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF

## HST Border

Assorted Darks from Fat $1 / 8^{\prime} \mathrm{s}$ - HST - (50) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ sq.

$$
\text { Tan\#2 - HST - (50) } 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \text { sq. }
$$

Piece (100) assorted dark HST as per instructions on page 12; trim to $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " square.

## Outer Border

Blue- outer borders - (4) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ LOF

$$
\text { binding - (4) } 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times L O F
$$

TIP: I prefer to cut my border strips length of fabric. The lengthwise grain stretches less making the outer borders more stable to frame your quilt.
