

Supply List for Wendy's Rainbow Swirl Runner Class

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This project can be a bed runner or a table runner. As pictured it finishes about 18" x 99", but that size is easily modified. In class, you can expect to finish at least one Rainbow Swirl block. You will learn how to use my Flying Geese Trimmer to make standard Flying Geese blocks as well as Extended Flying Geese.

The Runner as shown has 3 Rainbow Swirl blocks and 2 Geese Strip blocks. Up to 8 different colored fabrics can be used, plus the black background and a multicolor print for side setting triangles.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- 1 fat quarter each of 8 fabrics
- 1½ yards **Background** (black)
- ½ yard **Side Setting Triangles** (print)
- 1½ yards **Backing**
- ½ yard **Binding**

I know it can be difficult to find 8 fabrics for that colorful rainbow effect. But you do have options! You can choose to make the blocks with 6 colors, 4, 3 or even just 2 colors, as pictured below. You still need just 1 fat quarter of each fabric to make the entire runner. Or, if you want to learn the technique by making just one block, bring your colored fat quarters plus 1 fat quarter of Background fabric.

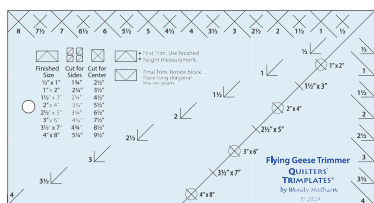

- Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Acrylic ruler for cutting squares up to 7½"
