



Cutting Instructions:

From red #4, cut:

♥ 8 squares, $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "

From cream #2, cut:

♥ 8 squares, $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "

From red #1, cut:

♥ 2 squares, $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ "

From green #3, cut:

♥ 2 squares, $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ "

Instructions:

1. Follow Steps 1 on page 23 of *Prairie Patchwork* for "Making the Sawmill Blocks", substituting the $2\frac{3}{4}$ " beige and dark squares with the $2\frac{3}{4}$ " red #1 and green #3 squares to make a four-patch unit measuring 5" square, including seam allowances.

2. Follow Step 2 on pages 23 – 24 of *Prairie Patchwork*, substituting the $2\frac{3}{8}$ " beige and dark squares with the $2\frac{3}{8}$ " red #4 and cream #2 squares to make 16 half-square triangle units measuring 2" square, including seam allowances.
3. Follow Steps 3 – 5 to make one Sawmill block measuring 8" square, including seam allowances.
