Cutting Instructions:

From red #4, cut:

♥ 8 squares, 23/8" x 23/8"

From cream #2, cut:

♥ 8 squares, 23/8" x 23/8"

From red #1, cut:

♥ 2 squares, 2¾" x 2¾"

From green #3, cut:

♥ 2 squares, 2¾" x 2¾"

Instructions:

1. Follow Steps 1 on page 23 of *Prairie Patchwork* for "Making the Sawmill Blocks", substituting the 2³/₄" beige and dark squares with the 2³/₄"red #1 and green #3 squares to make a four-patch unit measuring 5" square, including seam allowances.

- 2. Follow Step 2 on pages 23 24 of *Prairie Patchwork*, substituting the 23/8" beige and dark squares with the 23/8" red #4 and cream #2 squares to make 16 half-square triangle units measuring 2" square, including seam allowances.
- 3. Follow Steps 3 5 to make one Sawmill block measuring 8" square, including seam allowances.
