

## Cutting Instructions:

## From red \#4, cut:

- 8 squares, $23 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$

From cream \#2, cut:

- 8 squares, $23 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$

From red \#1, cut:
ヤ 2 squares, $23 / 4 \mathrm{ln} 23 / 4$ "
From green \#3, cut:
४ 2 squares, $23 / 4$ " x $23 / 4$ "

## Instructions:

1. Follow Steps 1 on page 23 of

Prairie Patchwork for "Making the Sawmill Blocks", substituting the $23 / 4$ " beige and dark squares with the 23/4"red \#1 and green \#3 squares to make a four-patch unit measuring 5 " square, including seam allowances.
2. Follow Step 2 on pages $23-24$ of Prairie Patchwork, substituting the $23 / 8$ " beige and dark squares with the $23 / 8$ " red \#4 and cream \#2 squares to make 16 half-square triangle units measuring 2 " square, including seam allowances.
3. Follow Steps 3 - 5 to make one Sawmill block measuring 8 " square, including seam allowances.
