



## Cutting Instructions:

### From cream #1, cut:

- ♥ 6 rectangles, 2" x 6½"
- ♥ 1 rectangle, 1½" x 4½"
- ♥ 2 squares, 1½" x 1½"
- ♥ 1 square, ¾" x ¾"
- ♥ 1 square, ⅞" x ⅞"

### From cream #3, cut:

- ♥ 2 rectangles, 1½" x 10½"
- ♥ 2 rectangles, 1½" x 6½"

### From red #1, cut:

- ♥ 5 squares, ⅞" x ⅞"
- ♥ 1 rectangle, 1½" x 2½"

### From green #3, cut:

- ♥ 1 rectangle, 1½" x 6½"
- ♥ 1 rectangle, 1½" x 4½"

## Instructions:

1. Follow Steps 1-2 on page 33 of *Prairie Patchwork*, substituting the ⅞" red #1 pieces for the pink pieces, and the ¾" cream #1 square for the beige square, to make 4 flying geese units measuring 1½" x 2½", including seam allowances (You'll have 3 extra).

2. Follow Step 3, substituting the ⅞" red #1 pieces for the pink pieces, and the ⅞" cream #1 pieces for the beige pieces, to make two half-square triangle units measuring 1½" square, including seam allowances.
3. Follow Steps 4–6 on page 34 of *Prairie Patchwork*, substituting the green #3 pieces for the brown pieces, and the cream #1 pieces for the beige pieces.
4. Follow Step 7, substituting the cream #3 pieces for the ecru pieces to complete one Prairie Flower block measuring 6½" x 12½", including seam allowances.
