# Prairie Patchwork Quilt Along







#### From cream #1, cut:

- **♥** 6 rectangles, 2" x 6½"
- **♥** 1 rectangle, 1½" x 4½"
- **♥** 2 squares, 1½" x 1½"
- **♥** 1 square, 3½" x 3½"
- **♥** 1 square, 17/8" x 17/8"

#### From cream #3, cut:

- **♥** 2 rectangles, 1½" x 10½"
- **♥** 2 rectangles, 1½" x 6½"

#### From red #1, cut:

- **♥** 5 squares, 1%" x 1%"
- **▼** 1 rectangle, 1½" x 2½"

### From green #3, cut:

- **v** 1 rectangle, 1½" x 6½"
- ▼ 1 rectangle, 1½" x 4½"

## **Instructions:**

1. Follow Steps 1-2 on page 33 of *Prairie Patchwork*, substituting the
17/8" red #1 pieces for the pink pieces, and
the 31/4" cream #1 square for the beige
square, to make 4 flying geese units
measuring 11/2" x 21/2", including seam
allowances (You'll have 3 extra).



- 2. Follow Step 3, substituting the 17/8" red #1 pieces for the pink pieces, and the 17/8" cream #1 pieces for the beige pieces, to make two half-square triangle units measuring 11/2" square, including seam allowances.
- 3. Follow Steps 4–6 on page 34 of *Prairie Patchwork*, substituting the green #3 pieces for the brown pieces, and the cream #1 pieces for the beige pieces.
- 4. Follow Step 7, substituting the cream #3 pieces for the ecru pieces to complete one Prairie Flower block measuring 6½" x 12½", including seam allowances.
