

## Cutting Instructions:

From cream \#1, cut:

- 24 squares, 2" x 2"

From cream \#3, cut:
ฤ 12 squares, $23 / 8 " \times 23 / 8 "$
From red \#2, cut:
『 6 squares, $2 "$ x $2^{\prime \prime}$

- 12 squares, $23 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$


## Instructions:

1. Follow Steps 1-2 on page 27 of Prairie Patchwork, under "Making the Friendship Star Blocks for St. Clair Sawmill", substituting the $23 / 8$ " cream \#3 squares for the beige print A squares, and the $2338^{\prime \prime}$ red \#2 squares for the brown print A squares. Substitute the 2 " red \#2 squares for one of the rust squares (center), and the $2^{\prime \prime}$ cream \#1 squares for the remaining rust squares. Make a total of 6 Friendship
Star blocks measuring 5" x 5", including seam allowances.
