


## Cutting Instructions:

From cream \#1, cut:
『 4 rectangles, $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

- 2 squares, $43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$


## From green \#1, cut:

- 2 squares, $43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4$ "

४ 1 square 2 " x $2^{\prime \prime}$

## Instructions:

1. Follow Step 1 on page 28 of Prairie Patchwork, substituting the cream \#1 squares for the cream squares, and the green \#1 squares for the brown squares. Make 16 units measuring 2 " square, including seam allowances.
2. Sew together two Step 1 units to make one row. Press the seam open. Make a total of 8 Step 2 rows.


3. Join two Step 2 rows together. Press the seam open. Make a total of four Step 3 units.

4. Sew a Step 3 unit to opposite sides of one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ " rectangle. Press the seams towards the rectangle. Make a total of two Step 4 units.

## Prairie Patchwork Quilt Along

5. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to opposite sides of the $2^{\prime \prime}$ green \#1 square. Press the seams towards the rectangle.

6. Join one Step 4 row to opposite sides of the Step 5 row to complete Block H, measuring $8 " \times 8 "$ including seam allowances. Press the seams open.

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
