

## Cutting Instructions:

### From cream #1, cut:

- ♥ 6 squares, 3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"; cut the squares into quarters diagonally to yield 24 triangles (blocks J-1 and J-2)
- ♥ 4 squares, 2" x 2" (block J-2)

### From green #2, cut:

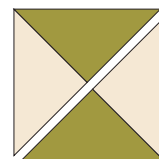
- ♥ 6 squares, 3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"; cut the squares into quarters diagonally to yield 24 triangles (blocks J-1 and J-2)
- ♥ 8 squares, 2" x 2" (blocks J-1)

### From red #7, cut:

- ♥ 3 squares, 2" x 2" (blocks J-1 and J-2)

## Instructions:

1. Follow Step 3 on page 9 of *Prairie Patchwork* under Hill Country, "Making the Pieced Columns", substituting the cream #1 triangles for the cream triangles, and the green #2 triangles for the pink or beige triangles. Press the seams towards the green triangles. Make 24 triangle units.
2. Join two triangle units together to make one quarter square triangle block. Press the seam open. The block will be oversized. Center and trim to measure 2" square including seam allowance. Repeat to make 12 quarter square triangle blocks, measuring 2" square including seam allowances.



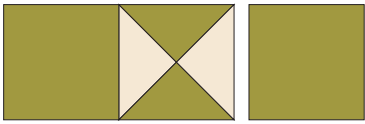

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# Prairie Patchwork Quilt Along

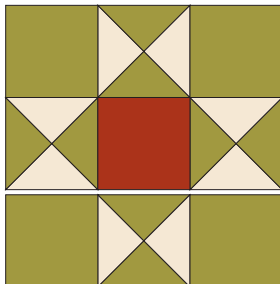
3. Join a 2" green #2 square to opposite sides of one quarter triangle block. Press seams towards the squares. Repeat for a total of four Step 3 rows.



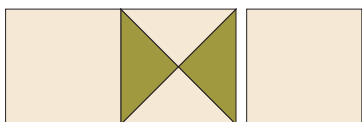
4. Join one quarter square triangle block to opposite sides of one 2" red #7 square. Press the seams towards the square. Repeat for a total of two Step 4 rows.



5. Join one Step 3 row to opposite sides of a Step 4 row, to make one J-1 block. Press the seams open. Repeat to make a second J-1 block. Each block should measure 5" square, including the seam allowances.



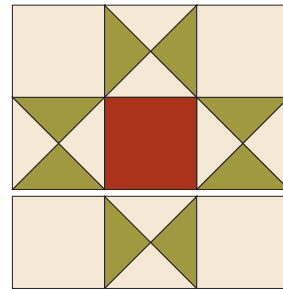
6. Join a 2" cream #1 square to opposite sides of one quarter square triangle block. Press seams towards the squares. Repeat for a total of two Step 6 rows.



7. Join one quarter square triangle block to opposite sides of one 2" red #7 square. Press the seams towards the square.



8. Join one Step 6 row to opposite sides of the Step 7 row to make the J-2 block. Press the seams open. The block should measure 5" square, including seam allowances.



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
