

## Cutting Instructions:

## From cream \#1, cut:

- 4 rectangles, $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 squares, $33 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$; cut the squares into quarters diagonally to yield 8 small triangles
From green \#4, cut:
- 5 squares, 2"x 2"
- $2-37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares; cut the squares into half diagonally to yield 4 large triangles


## Instructions:

1. Follow Step 1 on page 51 of Prairie Patchwork, under "Making the Setting Triangles" for Sunflower Fields, substituting the green \#4 squares for the red print A squares, and the cream \#1 small triangles for the beige small triangles. Make 4 units.
2. Sew one large green \#4 triangle to a Step 1 unit. Press the seam towards the large triangle. Repeat to make a total of 4 Step 2 units. Each unit should measure $31 / 2$ " including seam allowance.

3. Sew a Step 2 unit to opposite sides of one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cream \#1 rectangle. Press seams towards the rectangle. Repeat to make a second Step 3 unit.

4. Sew a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ cream $\# 1$ rectangle to opposite sides of the remaining 2 " green \#4 square. Press the seams towards the rectangles.

5. Sew a Step 3 unit to opposite sides of the Step 4 unit to complete one block P. Press the seams open. The block should measure 8 " square, including seam allowances.
