

## Cutting Instructions:

## From cream \#1, cut:

- 2 squares, $43 / 4$ " $\times 43 / 4$ "


## From red \#3, cut:

- 2 squares, $43 / 4 \times 43 / 4{ }^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 squares, $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$


## Instructions:

1. Follow Step 1 on page 28 of

Prairie Patchwork, under "Making the Sashing Units and Outer Borders" for St. Clair Sawmill, substituting the $43 / 4$ " cream \#1 squares for the cream squares, and the $43 / 4$ " red \#2 squares for the brown $B$ squares. Make a total of 16 half-square-triangle units measuring $2 " \times 2$ ", including seam allowances. You will use 10 units.
2. Sew two half-square-triangle units together to make a row as shown. Press the seams open. Repeat to make a second row.

3. Sew three half-square-triangle units together to make a row as shown. Press the seams open. Repeat to make a second row.

4. Sew a Step 2 row to the right side of a $31 / 2$ " red \#3 square as shown. Press the seam open. Repeat to make a second row.

5. Sew a Step 3 row to a

Step 4 row as shown. Press the seam open. Repeat to make a total of two "Q" blocks, each measuring 5 " square, including the seam allowances.
