

Cutting Instructions:

From cream #1, cut:

- ♥ 2 squares, $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{3}{4}$ "

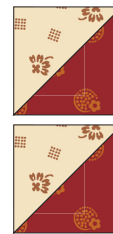
From red #3, cut:

- ♥ 2 squares, $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{3}{4}$ "
- ♥ 2 squares, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Instructions:

1. Follow Step 1 on page 28 of *Prairie Patchwork*, under "Making the Sashing Units and Outer Borders" for *St. Clair Sawmill*, substituting the $4\frac{3}{4}$ " cream #1 squares for the cream squares, and the $4\frac{3}{4}$ " red #2 squares for the brown B squares. Make a total of 16 half-square-triangle units measuring 2" x 2", including seam allowances. You will use 10 units.

2. Sew two half-square-triangle units together to make a row as shown. Press the seams open. Repeat to make a second row.



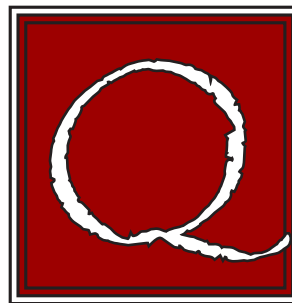
3. Sew three half-square-triangle units together to make a row as shown. Press the seams open. Repeat to make a second row.



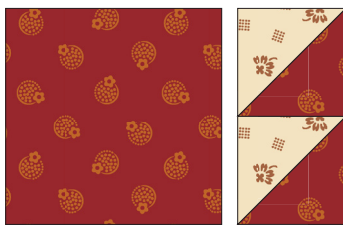

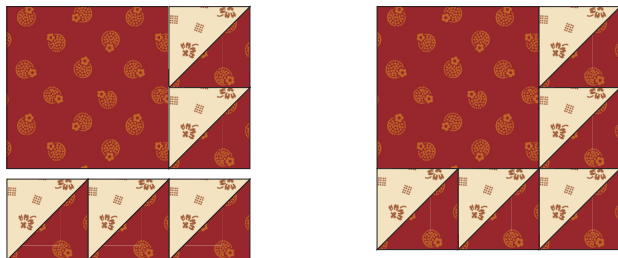

4. Sew a Step 2 row to the right side of a 3½" red #3 square as shown. Press the seam open. Repeat to make a second row.



5. Sew a Step 3 row to a Step 4 row as shown. Press the seam open. Repeat to make a total of two "Q" blocks, each measuring 5" square, including the seam allowances.
