


Prairie Patchwork Quilt Along







Cutting Instructions:

From cream #1, cut:


♥ 2 squares, 4³/₄" x 4³/₄"

From red #3, cut:

- ♥ 2 squares, 4³/₄" x 4³/₄"
- ♥ 2 squares, 3½" x 3½"

Instructions:


 Follow Step 1 on page 28 of *Prairie Patchwork*, under "Making the Sashing Units and Outer Borders" for *St. Clair Sawmill*, substituting the 4³/₄" cream #1 squares for the cream squares, and the 4³/₄" red #2 squares for the brown B squares. Make a total of 16 half-square-triangle units measuring 2" x 2", including seam allowances. You will use 10 units. 2. Sew two half-square-triangle units together to make a row as shown. Press the seams open. Repeat to make a second row.



3. Sew three half-square-triangle units together to make a row as shown. Press the seams open. Repeat to make a second row.




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Sew a Step 2 row to the right side of a 3¹/₂" red #3 square as shown. Press the seam open. Repeat to make a second row.



 Sew a Step 3 row to a Step 4 row as shown. Press the seam open. Repeat to make a total of two "Q" blocks, each measuring 5" square, including the seam allowances.





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
