

## Cutting Instructions:

### From cream #3, cut:

- ♥ 1 square,  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{3}{4}$ "
- ♥ 4 squares, 2" x 2"

### From red #2, cut:

- ♥ 1 square,  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{3}{4}$ "
- ♥ 1 square, 2" x 2"

## Instructions:

1. Follow Step 1 on page 28 of *Prairie Patchwork*, under "Making the Sashing Units and Outer Borders" for "St. Clair Sawmill", substituting the  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " cream #3 square for the cream square, and the  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " red #2 square for the brown B square. Make a total of 8 half-square-triangle units measuring 2" x 2", including seam allowances. You will use 4 units.

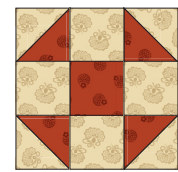
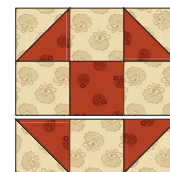
2. Sew a half-square-triangle unit to opposite sides of a cream square. Press the seams towards the square. Repeat to make a second row.



3. Sew a cream square to opposite sides of the red #2 square. Press the seams towards the red square.



4. Sew a Step 2 row to opposite sides of the Step 3 row to make the "R" block. Press the seams open. The block should measure 5" square, including seam allowances.



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
