

## Cutting Instructions:

From cream \#1, cut:

- 2 squares, $43 / 4 \mathrm{ln} \times 43 / 4$

From red \#2, cut:

- 2 squares, $43 / 4 \mathrm{n} \times 43 / 4$ "


## Instructions:

1. Follow Step 1 on page 28 of

Prairie Patchwork, under "Making the Sashing Units and Outer Borders" for St. Clair Sawmill, substituting the cream \#1 squares for the cream squares, and the red \#2 squares for the brown B squares. Make 16 half-square-triangle units measuring 2 " square, including seam allowances.. You will use 10 units.
2. Sew eight half-square-triangle units together as shown below to make one spacer $U$ unit. Press the seams open. You will use the additional two half-square-triangle units to make the spacer U/V unit.
