

Prairie Patchwork Quilt Along





Cutting Instructions:

From cream #1, cut:

♥ 2 squares, 4¾" x 4¾"

From red #2, cut:

♥ 2 squares, 4¾" x 4¾"

Instructions:

1. Follow Step 1 on page 28 of *Prairie Patchwork*, under "Making the Sashing Units and Outer Borders" for St. Clair Sawmill, substituting the cream #1 squares for the cream squares, and the red #2 squares for the brown B squares. Make 16 half-square-triangle units measuring 2" square, including seam allowances.. You will use 10 units.

2. Sew eight half-square-triangle units together as shown below to make one spacer U unit. Press the seams open. You will use the additional two half-square-triangle units to make the spacer U/V unit.
