Cutting Instructions:

From cream #1, cut:

♥ 3 squares, 4½" x4½"

From red #2, cut:


♥ 12 squares, 23/8" x 23/8"

Instructions:

1. Follow Steps 1- 2 on pages 58 - 59 of *Prairie Patchwork*, under "Making the Dogtooth Borders" for Church Picnic, substituting the cream #1 squares for the cream squares, and the red #2 squares for the dark teal squares. Make a total of 12 flying-geese units measuring 2" x 3½", including seam allowances. You will use 11 units.



2. Join three flying-geese units together to make one spacer unit V. Repeat to make a second spacer unit V.





3. Sew two flying- geese units and two blocks U together to make a row, as shown.



4. Sew three flying- geese units together to make a row, as shown.



4. Sew the Step 3 row and the Step 4 row together to make the spacer unit U/V, as shown.
