



Cutting Instructions:

From cream #1, cut:

- ♥ 3 squares, $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

From green #1, cut:

- ♥ 12 squares, $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "

Instructions:

1. Follow Steps 1- 2 on pages 58 - 59 of *Prairie Patchwork*, under "Making the Dogtooth Borders" for Church Picnic, substituting the $2\frac{3}{8}$ " cream #1 squares for the cream squares, and the $4\frac{1}{4}$ " green #1 squares for the dark teal squares. Make a total of 12 flying-geese units measuring 2 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", including seam allowances. You will use 9 units.



2. Join four flying-geese units and two blocks Y together to make one row. Press the seams open.



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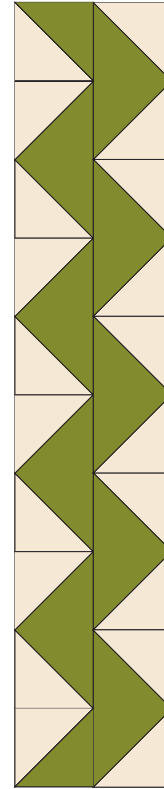

3. Join five flying-geese units together to make a second row. Press the seams open.



4. Join the Step 2 row and the Step 3 row together to make spacer unit Y/Z. Press the seam open.



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
