

Prairie Patchwork Quilt Along





Cutting Instructions:

From cream #1, cut:

♥ 3 squares, 4½" x 4½"

From green #1, cut:

♥ 12 squares, 23/8" x 23/8"

Instructions:

1. Follow Steps 1- 2 on pages 58 - 59 of *Prairie Patchwork*, under "Making the Dogtooth Borders" for Church Picnic, substituting the 23/8" cream #1 squares for the cream squares, and the 41/4" green #1 squares for the dark teal squares. Make a total of 12 flying-geese units measuring 2" x 31/2", including seam allowances. You will use 9 units.



2. Join four flying-geese units and two blocks Y together to make one row. Press the seams open.

3. Join five flying-geese units together to make a second row. Press the seams open.
