

## Beginning Embroidery Redwork Or Basic Color Pallet “Blooming Basket” Supply List

Embroidery has always been a deservedly popular hobby. It stimulates the imagination and at the same time provides an island of calm in the midst of a hussle-bussle world. Some may just need a refresher course. There will be sixteen stitches: Stem/Outline, Back stitch, Chevron, Herringbone, Chain, Turkey Work, Blanket Stitch, Lazy Daisy, French Knots, Straight, Satin, Seeding, Fishbone, Buttonhole Wheel, Spider Web Rose, & Cross Hatching (Cross).

### **Blooming Basket Pattern** by Quilt Ideas P30 (Required)

14” Square of Fabric to embroidery.

2 skein DMC Embroidery Floss #304 Red

OR 1 Skein

Floss for Multi-colored Light, Med, Dark Color Families  
Basket –Tan, Med Brown, Dark Brown

Flowers & Leaves -

Lavender/Purple/Dark Purple

Pink/Rose/Red

Pale Blue/Med Blue/Royal Blue

Light Yellow/Med Yellow/Dark Yellow

Light Green/Med Green/Dark Yellow

### **Supplies**

5/10 Asstd Sizes Embroidery Needles

Brown 01 Pigma Pen or Brown Gelly Roll Pen

Pin Cushion (required)

Pocket Guide to Embroidery Stitches

by Leisure Arts #56019

5” Spring Tension Embroidery Hoop or one you have

Embroidery Scissors

Reading Glasses (Magnifying) (optional)

### **Before Class:**

**Trace pattern** with a Brown 01 Micron pigma or Gelly Roll pen. Mark Lazy Daisy with only a dot at beginning of stitch. Mark French Knots with only a dot.
