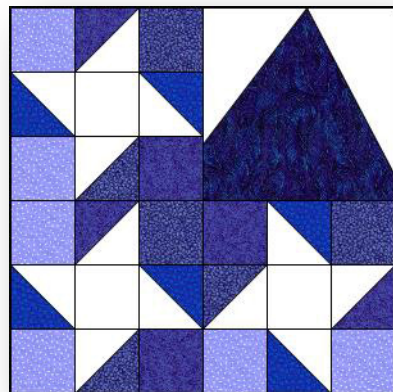
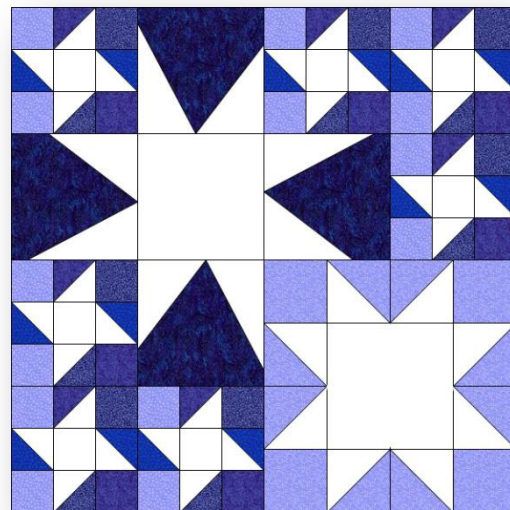


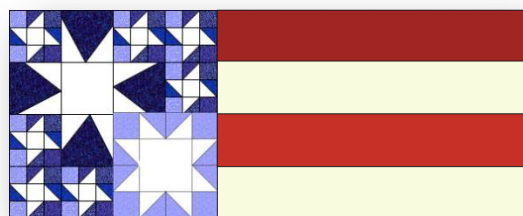
- 12 Assemble section two of your stars as illustrated, using 3 friendship stars and 1 step 9 unit.



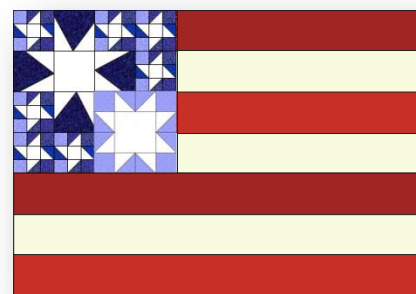
- 13 Assemble the star unit with the three sections you just built and the variable star you made earlier assemble the star unit as shown.



- 14 Sew the four stripe unit to the side of the stars with the red stripe at the top.



- 15 Sew the three stripe unit to the bottom of the stars and stripes unit.

Fabric Requirements

- 4 Blue Print 3 1/2" strips
- 2 White Solid 3 1/2" strips
- 3 White Print 3 1/2" strips
- 4 Red Print 3 1/2" strips
- 3/8 yard for binding
- 3/4 yard for backing

Cutting Instructions

- Blue fabric #1: (4) 3 1/2" square
- Blue fabric #2: (4) 2" square
(4) 2 3/8" square
- Assorted blues: (28) 1 1/2" square
(14) 1 7/8" square
- Solid white: (2) 3 1/2" square
(8) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle
(4) 2 3/8" square
(14) 1 7/8" square
(7) 1 1/2" square
- White background prints:
(3) 3 1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips
- Red background prints:
(4) 3 1/2" x WOF strips

Instructions

- 1 Alternating your red and white fabrics, sew one set of three (red, white, red) and one set of four (white, red, white, red) strips together.

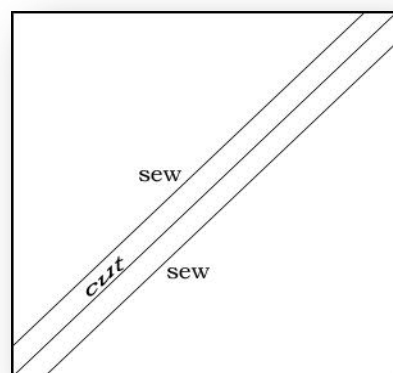
- 2 Trim the 3 strip piece to 42" long.

- 3 Trim your 4 strip piece to 30 1/2" long.

Set aside your two strip units.

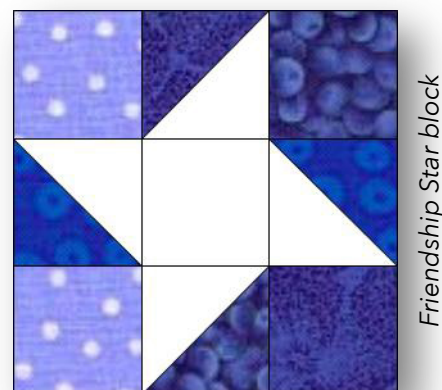
- 4 On your 1 7/8" and 2 3/4" white squares mark a line diagonally on the back from one corner to the opposite corner.

- 5 Put the white marked squares right sides together with the blue squares that match them in size, and sew 1/4 inch away from both sides of the line that you marked.



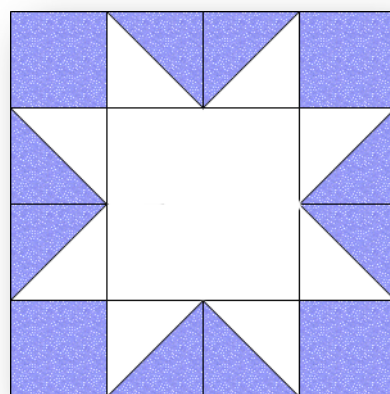
- 6 Cut on the marked line to separate the two halves. Open your half square triangles and press to the dark side.

- 7 Make 7 friendship star blocks by putting together your 1 1/2" half square triangles with your 1 1/2" squares of assorted blues and white. Sew together as illustrated.

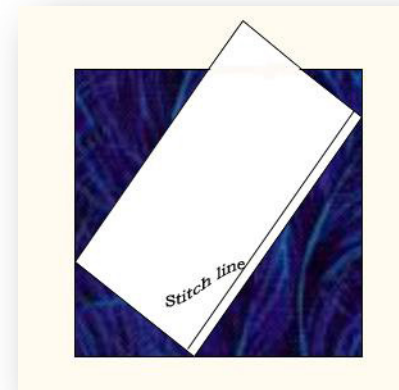


Set aside your friendship stars for later.

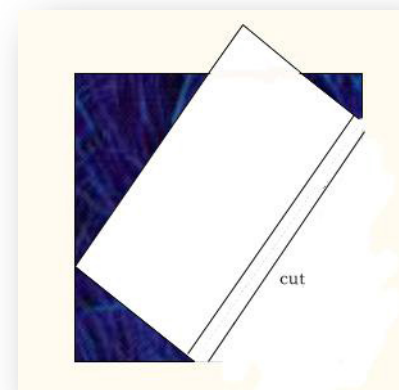
- 8 Using the 2" half square triangles you made in steps 4-6, the 2" blue squares, and one white 3 1/2" square, for the center, create a variable star block as illustrated.



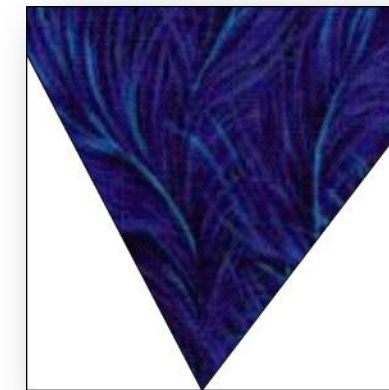
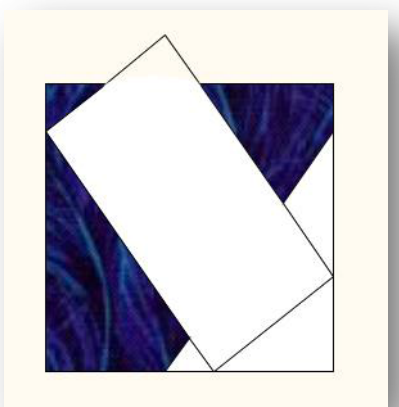
- 9 With the 3 1/2" blue squares and the 2 1/2" by 4 1/2" white rectangles make free pieced star points. Lay one rectangle diagonally across the bottom corner of one of the squares. Make sure that the rectangle crosses the center of the square at the bottom and that when sewn and folded down it covers the bottom corner.



Sew 1/4 inch away from the edge of the white rectangle that is toward the corner you are making as shown below. Trim along the edge of the white rectangle.

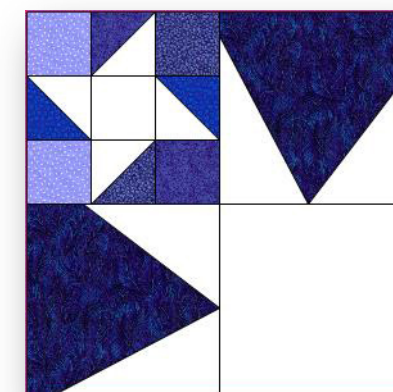


Fold the rectangle down and press. Trim away excess fabric, squaring to 3 1/2 inches. Repeat this process for the other bottom corner.



Repeat to make four units.

- 10 Assemble section one of stars as illustrated using 2 units from step 9, a friendship star, and a 3 1/2" white square.



- 11 Assemble section two of stars as illustrated, using 3 friendship stars and 1 step 9 unit.
