
## The Beginnings QAL



## Block 12 Cat (8" Finished)

For One Block (that is what you need for the quilt)

## Cut:

- 2 1 ½"by 8 ½" rectangles of Background Fabric
- 1- 3½"by 1½" rectangle of Background fabric
- 2 3 ½" squares of Background fabric
- 2 1 ½" squares of Ear Fabric
- $1-3 \frac{1}{2}$  by  $7 \frac{1}{2}$  rectangle of Body Fabric
- $1-3\frac{1}{2}$  by 5 1/2" rectangle of Body Fabric


<sup>\*\*</sup> all seams are ¼"

## Instructions:

1. Mark a diagonal line on the back of each of the 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " ear fabric squares and one of the 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of background fabric



 Place ear squares on the each side of the background 1 ½" by 3 ½" rectangle as shown.
Make sure the diagonal line goes from top left to bottom right on the left side. And the Top right to the bottom left on the right side.




3. Place background 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on the right side of the body 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 5 1/2" rectangles as shown. Make sure the diagonal line goes from top left to bottom right.



4. Place the unit created in step 1 on the top of the body 3 %" by 7 %" rectangle and sew them together.



5. Place the background 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on the top of the unit created in step 2 and sew.



6. Place the unit created in step 5 to the right of the unit created in step 4 and sew.



7. Place the background 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles on each side of the cat and sew.



And voila you are done!
