Fabric A	AHOM-6211-EMU.....	1 repeat
Fabric B	AHOM-6216-G.....	3/4 yard
Fabric C	AHOM-6220-O.....	1/2 yard
Fabric D	AHOM-6220-Z.....	1/4 yard
Fabric E	CMIL-6222-AU.....	7/8 yard*
Fabric F	CMIL-6222-ENE.....	1 1/2 yards
Backing	3 1/2 yards
Batting	68" x 30"

* Includes binding

Cutting Instructions (Both Runners):

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Fussy cut three 9 1/2" squares each centered on large block. **(Blocks)**
- Fussy cut three 7 1/2" squares each centered on small block. **(Blocks)**

Fabric B:

- Cut four 5" x WOF strips; sub-cut thirty-two 5" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric C:

- Cut two 5" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixteen 5" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric D:

- Cut three 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut six 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles and six 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**

Fabric E:

- Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut twenty-four 2 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut ten 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew together five 2 1/4" x WOF strips end to end with diagonal seams to make one binding strip. Repeat to make a second strip. **(Binding)**

Fabric F:

- Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut forty-eight 2 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut three 5" x WOF strips; sub-cut twenty-four 5" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut two 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles. **(Sashing)**

- Cut eight 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles from two WOF strips. Piece the remaining strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut four 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips. **(Outer Border)**

Backing:

- Cut four 30" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 30" x 68" rectangles.

Piecing Instructions (Runner One):

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric F** square on the top left corner of one 5" **Fabric B** square, right sides together. (Diagram 1) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 1) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make one 5" Unit 1 square. (Diagram 2) Repeat to make an additional fifteen Unit 1 squares.

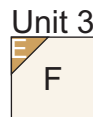

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 3-4 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make eight 5" Unit 2 squares and twelve 5" Unit 3 squares.

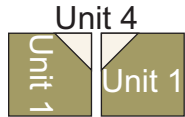


Unit 2

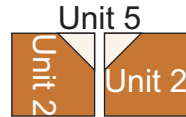


Unit 3

- Sew together two Unit 1 squares as shown to make one 5" x 9 1/2" Unit 4 rectangle. (Diagram 5) Repeat to make an additional seven Unit 4 rectangles.
- Sew together two Unit 2 squares as shown to make one 5" x 9 1/2" Unit 5 rectangle. (Diagram 6) Repeat to make an additional three Unit 5 rectangles.

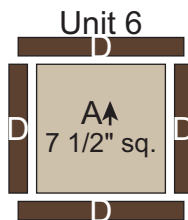

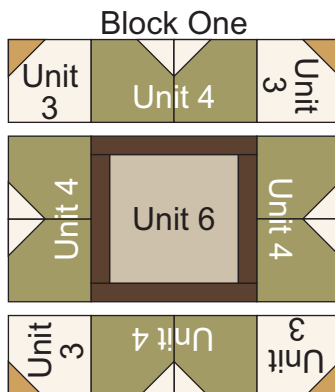
Make (4) = 5" x 9 1/2"

- Sew one 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangle to each side of one 7 1/2" **Fabric A** square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangle to the top and bottom of the **Fabric A** square to make one 9 1/2" Unit 6 square. (Diagram 7) Repeat to make an additional two Unit 6 squares.



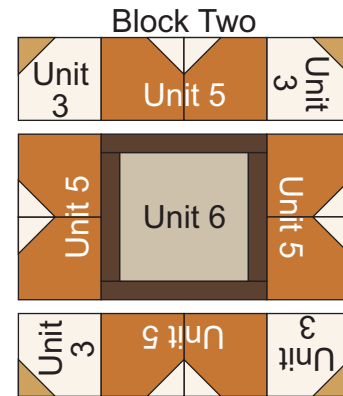
Make (3) = 9 1/2" x 9 1/2"

- Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew one Unit 3 square to each end of one Unit 4 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 4 rectangle to each side of one Unit 6 square to make the middle row. Sew together the three pieced rows lengthwise to make one 18 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 8) Repeat to make a second Block One square.

- Repeat Step 6 and refer to Diagram 9 for unit identification, placement and orientation to make one 18 1/2" Block Two square.



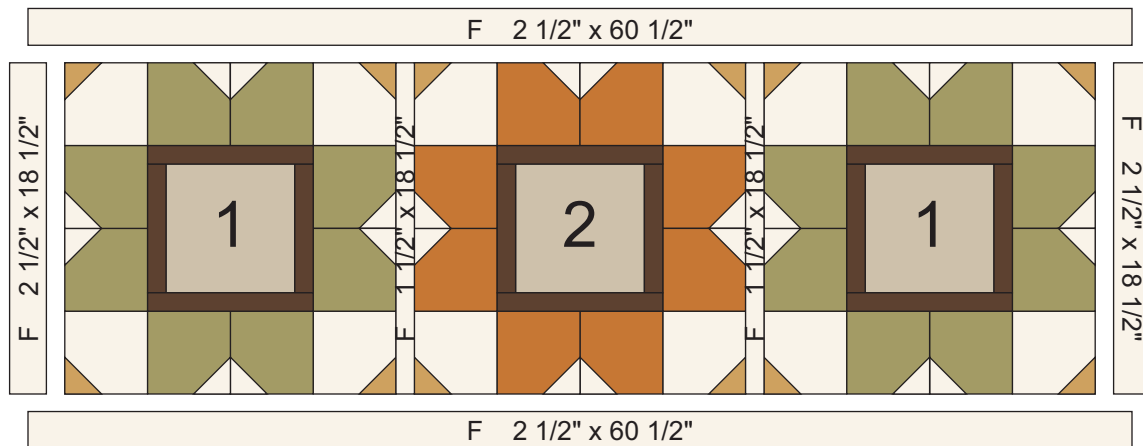
Make (1) = 18 1/2" x 18 1/2"

Runner Assembly (Runner One):

- Sew together one Block One square, one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangle, one Block Two square, one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangle and one Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make the 18 1/2" x 56 1/2" Runner One Center.
- Sew one 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" **Fabric F** strip to each side of the Runner One Center. Sew one 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" **Fabric F** strip to the top and bottom of the Runner One Center to make the Runner One Top.

Finishing (Runner One):

10. Layer the Runner One top, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
11. Quilt as desired.
12. Trim layers even with runner top, squaring corners.
13. Attach one pieced 2 1/4" **Fabric E** binding strip using your favorite method.



Runner One Diagram

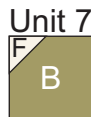
Piecing Instructions (Runner Two):

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

- Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric F** square on the top left corner of one 5" **Fabric B** square, right sides together. (Diagram 10) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 10) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make one 5" Unit 7 square. (Diagram 11) Repeat to make an additional fifteen Unit 7 squares.

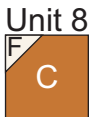

- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 12-13 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make eight 5" Unit 8 squares and twelve 5" Unit 9 squares.

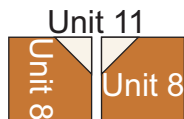

- Sew together two Unit 7 squares as shown to make one 5" x 9 1/2" Unit 10 rectangle. (Diagram 14) Repeat to make an additional seven Unit 10 rectangles.
- Sew together two Unit 8 squares as shown to make one 5" x 9 1/2" Unit 11 rectangle. (Diagram 15) Repeat to make an additional three Unit 11 rectangles.



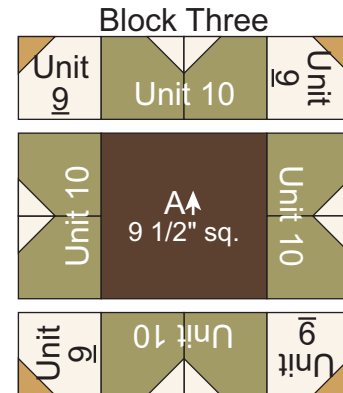

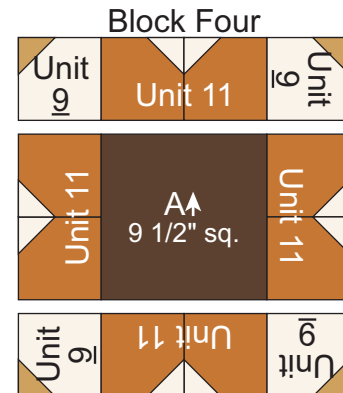
- Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew one Unit 9 square to each end of one Unit 10 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 10 rectangle to

each side of one 9 1/2" **Fabric A** square to make the middle row. Sew together the three pieced rows lengthwise to make one 18 1/2" Block Three square. (Diagram 16) Repeat to make a second Block Three square.

- Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagram 17 for unit identification, placement and orientation to make one 18 1/2" Block Four square.



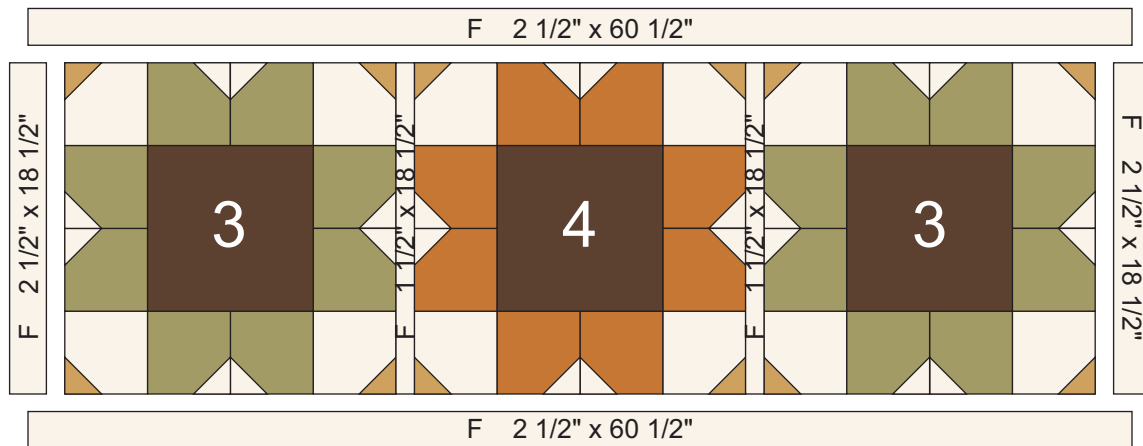
Make (1) = 18 1/2" x 18 1/2" unfinished

Runner Assembly (Runner Two):

- Sew together one Block Three square, one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangle, one Block Four square, one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangle and one Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make the 18 1/2" x 56 1/2" Runner Two Center.
- Sew one 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" **Fabric F** strip to each side of the Runner Two Center. Sew one 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" **Fabric F** strip to the top and bottom of the Runner Two Center to make the Runner Two Top.

Finishing (Runner Two):

9. Layer the Runner Two top, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
10. Quilt as desired.
11. Trim layers even with runner top, squaring corners.
12. Attach one pieced 2 1/4" **Fabric E** binding strip using your favorite method.

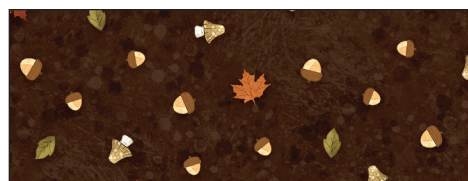

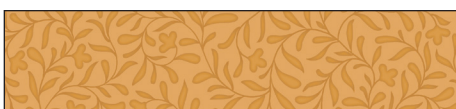

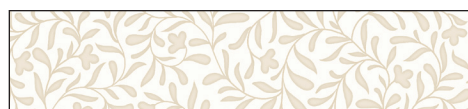
