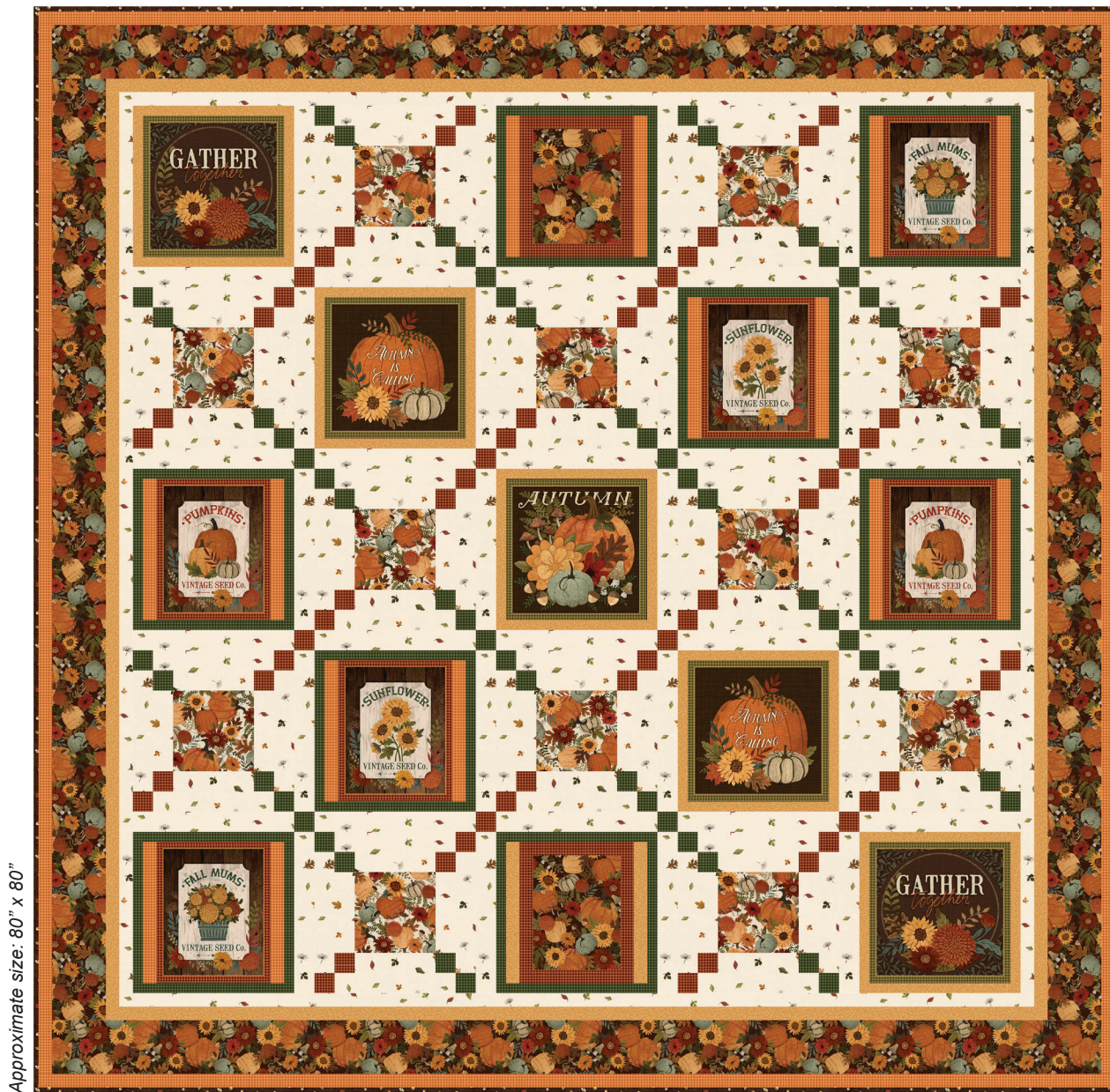

Fabric B	AHOM-6213-EMU	1/2 yard
Fabric C	AHOM-6213-ZMU.....	1 3/8 yards
Fabric D	AHOM-6217-E.....	2 1/2 yards
Fabric E	AHOM-6220-Z.....	3/4 yard*
Fabric F	CMIL-6222-AU.....	2/3 yard
Fabric G	CMIL-6223-G.....	3/4 yard
Fabric H	CMIL-6223-I.....	3/8 yard
Fabric I	CMIL-6223-O.....	3/4 yard
Backing (108")	2 1/2 yards
Batting	88" x 88"

* Includes binding

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Fussy cut five 11" squares and six 9" x 11" rectangles each centered on a block. **(Blocks A & B)**

Fabric B:

- Cut two 6 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut twelve 6 1/2" squares. **(Block D)**

Fabric C:

- Cut eight 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 4 1/2" x 70 1/2" strips and two 4 1/2" x 78 1/2" strips. **(3RD Border)**
- Cut one 7" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 7" x 9" rectangles. **(Block C)**

Fabric D:

- Cut eight 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 68 1/2" strips. **(1ST Border)**
- Cut fourteen 2" x WOF strips; sub-cut forty 2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. **(Sashing)**
- Cut six 2" x WOF strips for strip piecing. **(Block D)**
- Cut eight 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut forty-eight 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. **(Block D)**

Fabric E:

- Cut nine 2 1/2" x WOF strips. **(Binding)**

Fabric F:

- Cut seven 1 1/4" x WOF strips; sub-cut ten 1 1/4" x 11" rectangles and ten 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" rectangles. **(Block A)**
- Cut eight 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 68 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 70 1/2" strips. **(2ND Border)**

Fabric G:

- Cut eleven 1 1/4" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixteen 1 1/4" x 11" rectangles and sixteen 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks B & C)**
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips for strip piecing. **(Block D)**
- Cut one 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 2" squares. **(Sashing Squares)**

Fabric H:

- Cut two 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 1 1/2" x 9" rectangles. **(Block C)**
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips for strip piecing. **(Block D)**
- Cut one 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 2" squares. **(Sashing Squares)**

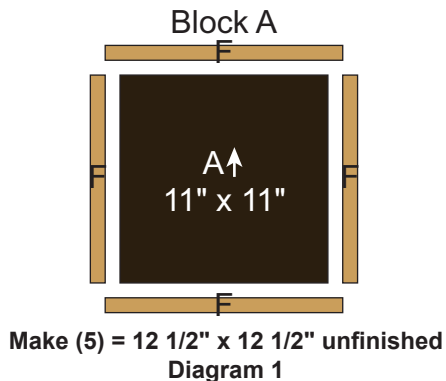
Fabric I:

- Cut six 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixteen 1 1/2" x 11 rectangles. **(Blocks B & C)**
- Cut eight 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 78 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 80 1/2" strips. **(4TH Border)**

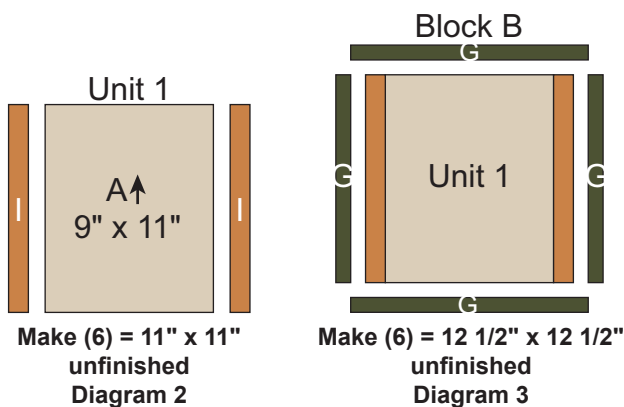
Piecing Instructions:

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Sew one 1 1/4" x 11" **Fabric F** rectangle to each side of one 11" **Fabric A** square. Sew one 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangle to the top and bottom of the **Fabric A** square to make one 12 1/2" Block A square. (Diagram 1) Repeat to make an additional four Block A squares.

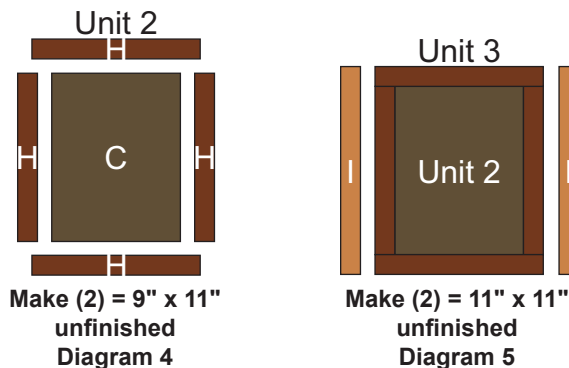


2. Sew one 1 1/2" x 11" **Fabric I** rectangle to each side of one 9" x 11" **Fabric A** rectangle to make one 11" Unit 1 square. (Diagram 2) Repeat to make an additional five Unit 1 squares.
3. Sew one 1 1/4" x 11" **Fabric G** rectangle to each side of one Unit 1 square. Sew one 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" **Fabric G** rectangle to the top and bottom of the Unit 1 square to make one 12 1/2" Block B square. (Diagram 3) Repeat to make an additional five Block B squares.

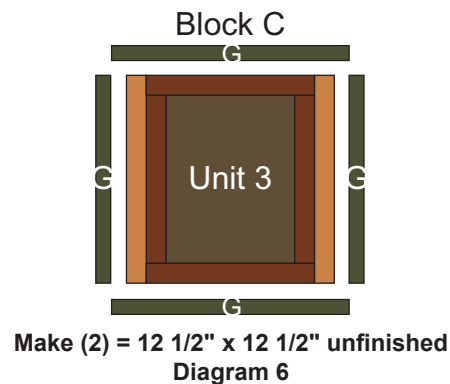


4. Sew one 1 1/2" x 9" **Fabric H** rectangle to each side of one 7" x 9" **Fabric C** rectangle. Sew one 1 1/2" x 9" **Fabric H** rectangle to the top and bottom of the **Fabric C** rectangle to make one 9" x 11" Unit 2 rectangle. (Diagram 4) Repeat to make a second Unit 2 rectangle.

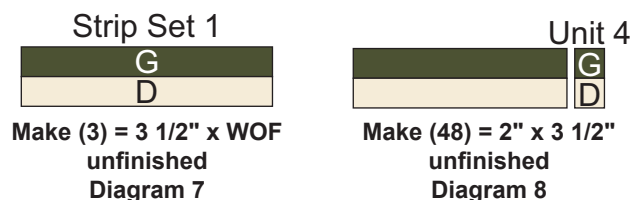
5. Sew one 1 1/2" x 11" **Fabric I** rectangle to each side of one Unit 2 rectangle to make one 11" Unit 3 square. (Diagram 5) Repeat to make a second Unit 3 square.



6. Sew one 1 1/4" x 11" **Fabric G** rectangle to each side of one Unit 3 square. Sew one 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" **Fabric G** rectangle to the top and bottom of the Unit 4 square to make one 12 1/2" Block C square. (Diagram 6) Repeat to make a second Block C square.

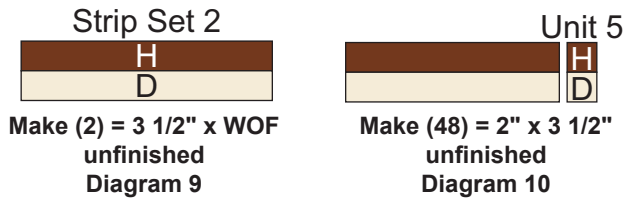


7. Sew one 2" x WOF **Fabric G** strip to the top of one 2" x WOF **Fabric D** strip to make one 3 1/2" x WOF Strip Set 1. (Diagram 7) Repeat to make an additional two Strip Set 1's.
8. From the three Strip Set 1's cut forty-eight 2" x 3 1/2" Unit 4 rectangles. (Diagram 8)

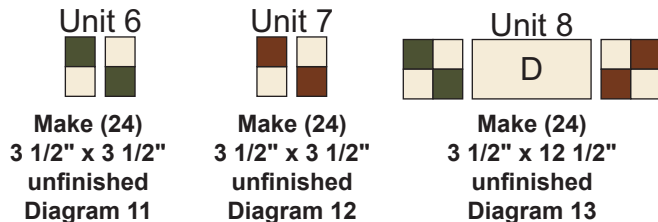


9. Sew one 2" x WOF **Fabric H** strip to the top of one 2" x WOF **Fabric D** strip to make one 3 1/2" x WOF Strip Set 2. (Diagram 9) Repeat to make a second Strip Set 2.

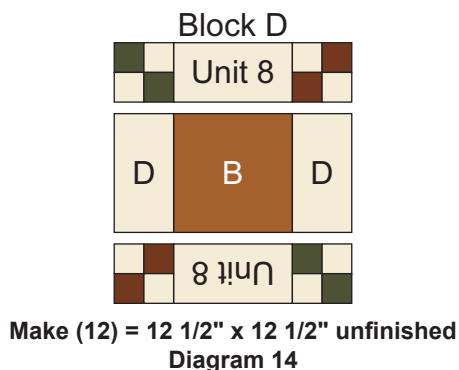
10. From the two Strip Set 2's cut forty-eight 2" x 3 1/2" Unit 5 rectangles. (Diagram 10)



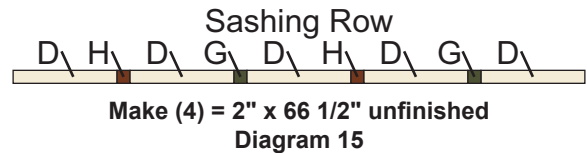
11. Sew together two Unit 4 rectangles as shown to make one 3 1/2" Unit 6 square. (Diagram 11) Repeat to make an additional twenty-three Unit 6 squares.
12. Sew together two Unit 5 rectangles as shown to make one 3 1/2" Unit 7 square. (Diagram 12) Repeat to make an additional twenty-three Unit 7 squares.
13. Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew together one Unit 6 square, one 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangle and one Unit 7 square, in that order from left to right, to make one 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" Unit 8 rectangle. (Diagram 13) Repeat to make an additional twenty-three Unit 8 rectangles.



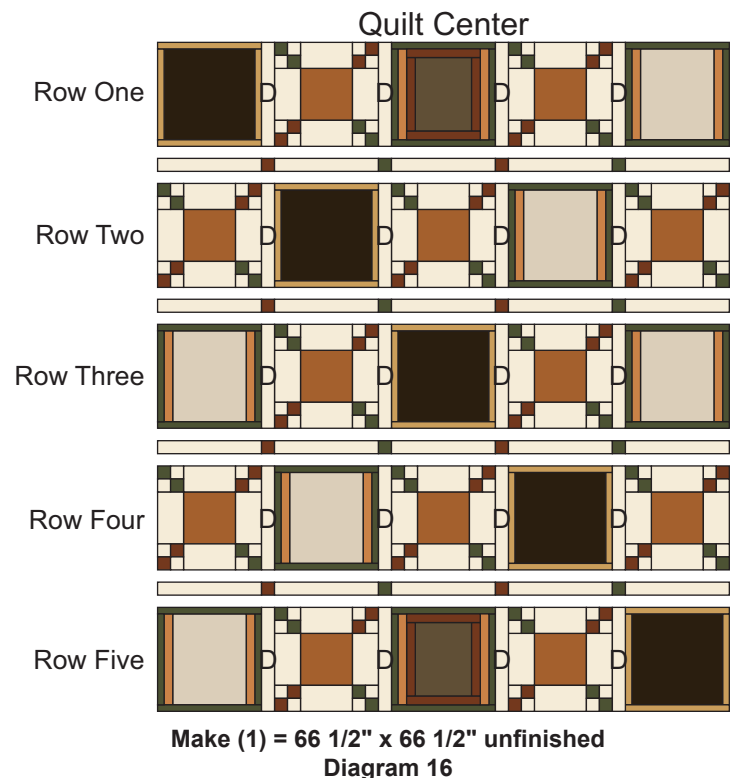
14. Sew one 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangle to each side of one 6 1/2" **Fabric B** square. Sew one Unit 8 rectangle to the top and bottom of the newly sewn rectangle as shown to make one 12 1/2" Block D square. (Diagram 14) Repeat to make an additional eleven Block D squares.



15. Sew together five 2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangles, two 2" **Fabric H** squares and two 2" **Fabric G** squares as shown to make one 2" x 66 1/2" Sashing Row. (Diagram 15) Repeat to make an additional three Sashing Rows.



16. Sew together one Block A square, four 2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangles, two Block D squares, one Block C square and one Block B square as shown to make Row One. (Diagram 16)
17. Repeat Step 16 and refer to Diagram 16 for block/fabric identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Five.
18. Sew together the five pieced Rows in numerical order and four Sashing Rows, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the 66 1/2" x 66 1/2" Quilt Center. (Diagram 16)



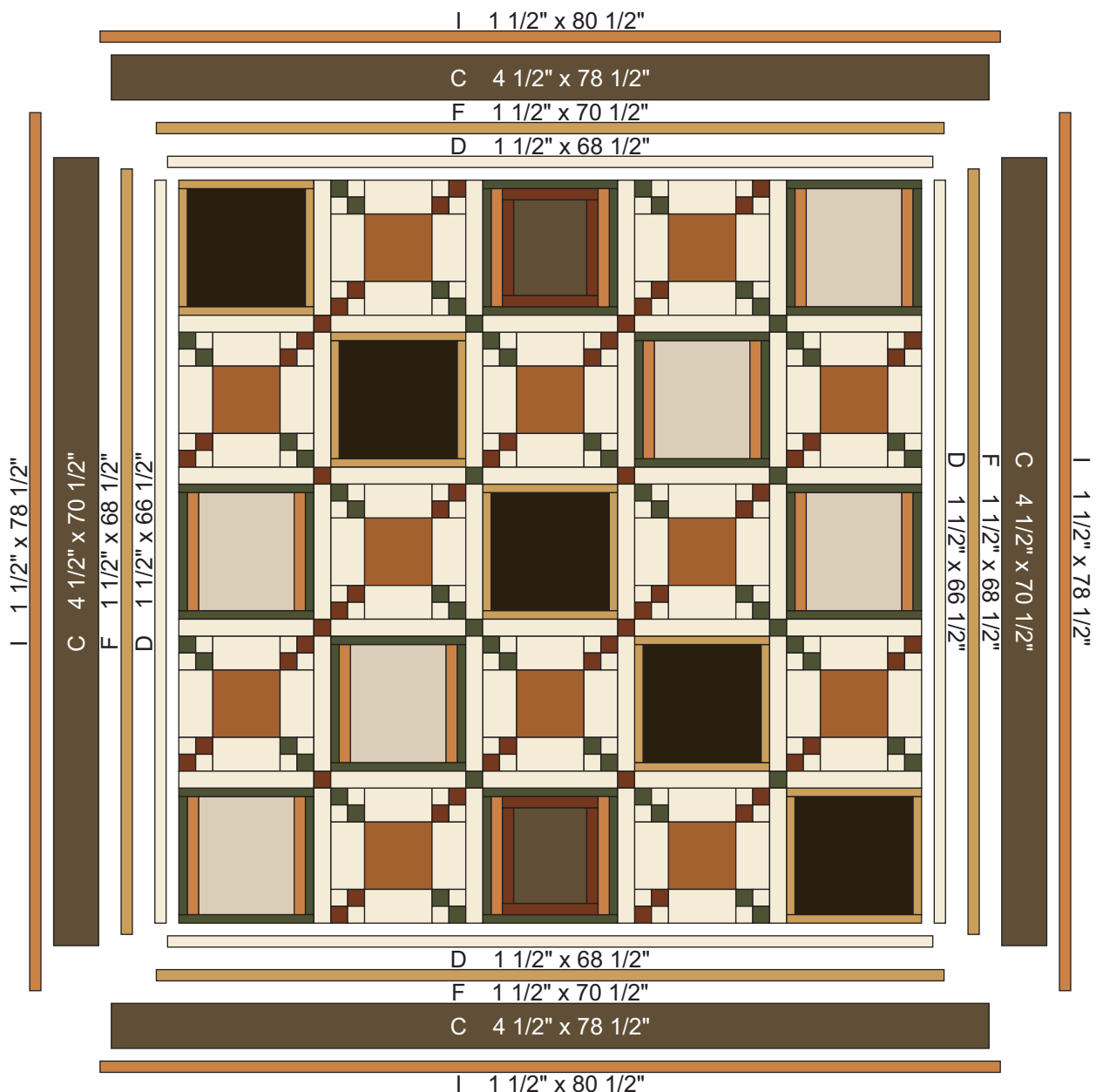
Quilt Assembly:

19. Sew one 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" **Fabric D** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 1 1/2" x 68 1/2" **Fabric D** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.

20. Sew one 1 1/2" x 68 1/2" **Fabric F** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 1 1/2" x 70 1/2" **Fabric F** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
21. Sew one 4 1/2" x 70 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 4 1/2" x 78 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
22. Sew one 1 1/2" x 78 1/2" **Fabric I** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 1 1/2" x 80 1/2" **Fabric I** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing:

23. Press backing well and trim to 88" x 88".
24. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
25. Quilt as desired.
26. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
27. Attach 2 1/2" **Fabric E** binding strips using your favorite method.
