

FINISHED PLACEMAT SIZE 15 ½" × 15 ½"

Please read all instructions before beginning this project.
Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any updates before starting this project.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric
LOF = Length of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Egg Hunt collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) PD17141-PANEL Egg Hunt Large Patch Panel

Additional Fabrics:

½ yard C17146-AQUA Egg Dye Dots
¼ yard C17149-RED Stripes (binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies
⅝ yard C17147-AQUA Jelly Beans (backing)
Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Egg Hunt Large Patch Panel

Fussy cut (1) 11 ½" × 11 ½" Panel square, centered over the motif of your choice.*

*Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size.



Aqua Egg Dye Dots

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:
(2) 2 ½" × 15 ½" rectangles. Label as A.
Cut (2) 2 ½" × LOF strips. Subcut:
(2) 2 ½" × 11 ½" rectangles. Label as B.

*Note: B-rectangles are cut LOF so the color names on the fabric are upright in the finished placemat.



Red Stripes

Cut (2) 2 ½" × WOF strips for binding.

SEWING TECHNIQUES


Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Placemat Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

EGG HUNT PLACEMAT

PLACEMAT ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **B**-rectangle to each side of the Panel square as shown below. Next, sew (1) **A**-rectangle to the top and bottom to complete the placemat top. Make sure all fabrics are facing upright.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

2. Layer the placemat top, batting, and backing. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Red Stripes binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished placemat using your favorite binding method.
