Project Requirements:

Green Fabric for Tractor Body	5" x 7" scrap
Black Print for Tires	4" x 7" scrap
Gray Print for Window	2" x 3" scrap
White Fabric for Tire Centers (optional)	2" x 3" scrap (if not using buttons)
Medium Black Ric Rac	3/8 yard
1 1/2" White Button	1 each
3/4" White Button	1 each
Onesie	
Matching Thread	
Applique Materials of Your Choice	
Ball Point Needle

Project Directions:

1. Prepare applique pieces using the patterns provided. The tractor and window have also been reversed to allow for fusible applique.
 - a. Tractor from green fabric
 - b. Tires from black fabric
 - c. Window from gray fabric
 - d. Tire Centers from white fabric if not using buttons

2. Using a washable glue stick, attach the black ric rac to the outside edge of the large tire on the wrong side. Be sure to start with the ric rac pointed toward the center of the tire. Overlap the beginning and end with the ric rac, again pointing toward the center of the tire.

3. Applique the prepared pieces in the following order:
 - a. Tractor Body
 - b. Window
 - c. Tires
 - d. Tire Centers

****** If using buttons for the tire centers, be sure to attach them securely to prevent any kind of choking hazard. ******
