



### Red

(10) 3.5" x 3.5" - 1/4 yard or fat quarter

(2) 8.25" x 8.25"

### White

(10) 3.5" x 3.5" - 5/8 yard or 3 fat quarters

(4) 8.25" x 8.25"

(2) 6.5" x 6.5" (star centers)

### Blue

(8) 3.5" x 3.5" - 1/4 yard or fat quarter

(2) 8.25" x 8.25"

### Border:

1/3 yard cut into 2.5" strips (4 strips WOF)

### Binding:

1/3 yard cut into 2.5" strips (4 strips WOF)

### Backing:

1 yard cut into 18" strips (2 strips WOF) - domestic quilting

1.5 yards cut into 25" strips (2 strips WOF) - longarm quilting

Take (2)red 8.5" square and (2)white 8.5" square and place them on top of each other, right sides together. Draw a line diagonal on the light colored fabric, from corner to corner, making a large "X" across the square. Sew a 1/4" away from the lines on both sides of the drawn line. See image A below. Then cut from corner to corner, top to bottom, and side to side, see image B below. This will give you 8 half square triangles (HST). Iron HST's open and square up each HST to a 3.5" square. Repeat with the (2)blue 8.25" square and (2)8.25" white squares. You now have all the HST to put this runner together. Layout according to the picture above. Sew together with a 1/4" seam allowance. Border and bind with the 2.5" strips.
