

Midnight Sparkle Center Block Class Supply List

This class will show you how to make the Lone Star without Y seams and turned edge applique by machine!

Being prepared for class will allow you to get the most out of the class.

- Spray starch and cut colored fabrics as required by pattern for the center star.
- Note that the background for the center is different from the background for the outside squares of the quilt. Cut four 15” squares and one 25” square (**not** like the pattern says), spray starch these pieces as well
- Frixion pen
- Small ruler (I used a 2 ½” x 6” – bring what you have)
- Painter’s tape
- Numbered pins (if you have them, or paper to number the sections)
- Spray starch such as Best Press or Magic Sizing.
- ½” bias tape maker and optional wonder tape
- Fine point wash-out glue stick
- Applique Paper or Stitch and Peel paper. Trace the applique designs on this paper.
- Good quality invisible thread (like Superior or Aurifil) or 100 wt. Micro Quilter thread
- Sewing machine with blind hem stitch and open toe foot for sewing machine
- Microtex machine needles (size 80 if using invisible thread, size 60 if using Micro Quilter thread)
- Bobbin wound with bobbin weight thread or lightweight polyester thread
- Applique pattern traced out on large piece of paper (you will need the pattern from the book for placement of applique shapes).
- Fabric scissors, paper scissors, thread snips, seam ripper, pins
