### Post Season - Tournament will begin, the first Wednesday after the season ends.

1. All bats must have the 2012NSA, ASA Stamp or 1.2 BPF -USSSA bat stamp. No stamp - no good. A out will be called for bat bats entering the batter's box. Men's league must swing real wood. Wood Baseball bats are approved. **New Stamp will be required for 2022 season.**

2. Home run rule will be a one up rule. When a HR is hit in a non allowed time it will be dead ball out. Women homeruns are unlimited.
3. Line Drives up the middle that hit the pitcher (over or in front of the pitching plate) will result in a dead ball out. A short-hop will be considered the same as a line drive. The pitcher must have time to react. A pitcher gloving a ball in self defense will also be considered as an out.
4. Home team is listed first.
5. Roster must be turned in at or before your first game.  
Rosters are on site to add players, up to the **8th of Sept.** Only two HS aged players are per team. Rosters freeze **Sept. 9th** If you don't have a roster, your season ends.....  
Illegal players will result in forfeit of the night. And eliminate you from post season play.  
The umpire will enforce this rule without request of the opposing team.  
Team requests of roster checks must take place prior to the completion of the second inning.  
Late players may be question upon arrival.
6. Games are 7 innings. **Only 1 extra inning (international) will be played. Then the game will end tied. Flip Flop rules will be used in all games. Mercy Rules: 12 runs after 4 innings - 10 runs after 5 innings.**
7. Need at least 6 players present to play. Present at game time. **No Auto outs.**  
First game is the only game that will wait (10 minute max) to start due to players. All other game time are forfeit time. So be on time. Clock will start on scheduled game time.
8. If a man walks he will go to 2nd base. The female batter will bat, unless there are 2 outs. Then she will have the option to walk or bat.
9. You need team shirts with a number for the 2nd game. Matching shirts is highly suggested.  
Players without a numbered shirt will not be allowed to play. Help yourself and team. This is very simple.
10. With a female batter, outfielders must stay behind the white line until the ball is hit. Infields must be on the dirt. Male batters, the defense can play anywhere.
11. No smoking, drinking or bringing **(NO)** dogs in the park. E- cig is considered smoking. A second violation of this rule will result in forfeiture of post season play. Also include a good old visit with Matt, prior to your team returning to the park.
12. League play rules will be governed by modified baseball rules. Comment sense stuff. Players that opt to not side when a play is being made will be called out for interference.
13. Foul balls. A batter may hit a foul ball for strike two. The following foul will be an out.
14. Strike zone is at the discretion of the umpire. Come to hit. Balls shall raise at least 6 feet and not above 12 feet. Come to hit, walking Stinks. If you complain at the umpire over balls and strikes you are open for ejection.
15. Due to complaints, the batting line-up will be set. No sliding line ups. Extra genders will be allowed to platoon in a spot.

Note: Chase your fouls balls and Homeruns. Game balls are limited to 2 per game. We can raise fees, if you don't want to retrieve balls. Let us know.....

Note #2: Leave the umpire alone. Slow pitch softball is not that challenging or important enough to embarrass yourself.
