Approval of the January 5, 2022 DRC Minutes

Bruce Ward made a motion to approve the January 5, 2022 DRC minutes with condition to change the following. Line 41, R-12 R-10. Chief Brad James seconded the motion. All members of the Committee voted in favor. 6-0

Final Plat – Selman Ridge Phase 2 (50 east 1400 south

Selman Ridge Phase Two is located in the R-15 zone at 50 east 1400 south. Dean Ingram stated that lot 8 in Selman Ridge Phase One changed its shape because of the revised storm drain plan. Bruce Ward stated that the revised storm drain plan for the Selman Ridge Phase Two Subdivision has been reviewed by the Engineering Department. Bruce Ward asked Ted Barnett if the SESD power line in Selman Ridge Phase Two is going to be relocated. Dean Ingram stated that he plans to leave the SESD power line where it is currently located. Ted Barnett mentioned that Robert Nelson told him that he plans to leave the SESD power line where it is currently located in the future Loafer Mountain View Plat H Subdivision. Steve Cox requested that a site plan showing easements is submitted with each house plan in the Selman Ridge Phase Two Subdivision. The DRC wanted to discuss the improvements of the entrance (located between lots 32, 33 and 34) to the City Well. Dean Ingram stated that the back property line improvements (fencing) of lots 32, 33, and 34 will be the home owner's responsibility. Matt Marziale stated that he would prefer a road that has road base and asphalt for the entrance to

the City Well. Bruce Ward stated that he would like to see a twelve foot wide asphalt road with road base and landscape rock on each side of the road. Ted Barnett mentioned that he needs electrical conduit in the City Well access road. Ted Barnett stated that he needs a four inch electrical conduit and John Bowcut needs a two inch fiber conduit in the access road as well. The DRC stated that Salem City will keep the existing fence around the City Well. Ted Barnett stated that he has a preliminary power plan for the Selman Ridge Phase Two Subdivision currently. John Bowcut stated that he wants a three inch conduit placed in the Selman Ridge Drive in addition to the two inch conduit. The DRC mentioned that there will need to be a second access provided to the Selman Ridge Phase Two Subdivision no matter what the status is of the future Loafer Mountain View Plat H Subdivision. Chief Brad James asked if the city has any authority to require construction trucks to take specific routes. Chief Brad James stated that he would request that construction traffic uses 11200 south and not the Loafer Canyon Bridge when the bridge is constructed. Bruce Ward stated that the developer can have a lot of control with the route of the construction traffic. The DRC stated that they will do their best to work with the developer to keep the construction off of 50 east as much as possible.

Bruce Ward made a motion to approve the Selman Ridge Phase Two Final Plat Subdivision subject to compliance of all Salem City standards and ordinances with the following conditions.

- 1. The 25 foot easement access to the City Well will be a 12 foot asphalted road with landscape rock on each side of the asphalt.
- 2. A 4 inch electrical conduit and a 2 inch fiber conduit placed in the access road to the City
 Well.
 - 3. 3 inch fiber conduit constructed in Selman Ridge Drive.
 - 4. Make appropriate changes to the Selman Ridge Phase 1 construction drawings (changes due to revised storm drain plan).
 - 5. Complete final redlines made by the Salem City Engineering Department on the Selman Ridge Phase Two Subdivision plan set.
