- 21 a. March 13, 2024
- 22 Walter Bird made a motion to approve the March 13, 2024, DRC minutes. Steve Cox seconded
- the motion. All members of the committee voted in favor. 6-0

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- 25 Decision: Capital Improvement Salem Fields Off-Site Sewer (Approx. 750 N Main St.)
- 26 Bradey Wilde stated that the off-site sewer project will be constructed from 750 N to 1100 N on
- 27 Main St. This project is required to be constructed for the Salem Fields and Viridian Farm MPD
- developments. Bradey Wilde stated that the plans meet the Salem City standards. It was
- 29 mentioned that a portion of the project is reimbursable.
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- 31 Steve Cox made a motion to approve the Salem Fields Off-Site Sewer Capital Improvement
- 32 subject to compliance with all Salem City Standards and Ordinances. Adam Clements seconded
- the motion. All members of the committee voted in favor. 6-0

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35 Discussion: Site Plan – Loafer Industrial Plat A (1179 N 1750 W)

- 36 Chad Campbell mentioned that they have a new layout for their proposed site plan. The
- 37 proposed site plan was shown. The infrastructure for the project has not changed from the old
- site plan. The proposed buildings are classic and look good. Adam Clements stated that the
- 39 project can have three phase power. Chad Campbell explained the sizes of the buildings. The
- 40 developers believe that a smaller suite in a building will sell easier. Chad Campbell believes that
- 41 the proposed buildings are better than the original proposal. Chad Campbell wanted to know if
- 42 the city was okay with the new buildings. The development will be constructed in phases. Chad
- 43 Campbell stated that they are planning to improve the frontage of the property in the first phase.
- 44 The storm drain system will be changing with the new layout. Bradey Wilde stated that the storm

- 45 drain system will need to meet Salem City standards. Bradey Wilde stated that the developer
- 46 may need to coordinate with the Benjamin drainage district. Adam Clements and Chad Campbell
- 47 discussed where the power connections to the new buildings will be located. The developer is
- 48 planning to construct block buildings Steve Cox mentioned that block buildings are structurally
- 49 strong and will last for a long time. Chad Campbell stated that the buildings will bring in a variety
- 50 of businesses. The DRC likes the layout of the new buildings proposed. Adam Clements stated
- 51 that the power will need to be switched from Rocky Mountain Power to Salem City Power. The
- 52 developer will need to pay for the changeover cost.
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- 54 Steve Cox made a motion to adjourn. Walter Bird seconded the motion. All members of the
- 55 committee voted in favor. 6-0
