The following items may be brought to the Green Waste Yard

- Tree branches - 4 inches in width and smaller,
- Grass clipping, please put them in designated area.
- Garden waste is approved. Leaves are welcome.
- Trimmed branches and shrub clippings.

All vehicles will need to have proof of residency with them.

An ID with address or a current city bill. Local residents only. No professional landscape companies or tree cutting companies

RV DUMP REMINDER.

The RV dump is a nice little privilege for the residents of Salem, so please take care of it and abide by the rules and follow the instructions on how to properly dump your holding tanks to eliminate spills and contamination.

First rule of business is the water is **NOT POTABLE WATER, DO NOT DRINK!!**

Instructions:

1. Secure drain hose to your holding tank.
2. Place drain end of hose into sewer opening. Hold cover opening.
3. Open trailer tank drain valve.

Wash any spilled waste into sewer.

The site is monitored. If caught just dumping your tank without the drain hose connected, dumping it on the ground and just trying to spray all your waste down the hole, you will faced with a very unnecessary and expensive fine! **The Improper Discharge to the Sewer System is not less then \$500 and not more than \$3000 per occurrence or day if more than one day.**

So don't be a Cousin Eddie and help keep Salem clean.

Women's Grass Volleyball: For women 18+. Limited space. Registration begins April 6th.

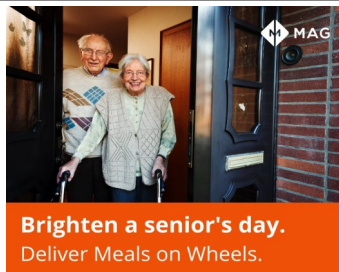
Summer Flag Football: For 3rd – 8th grade. Registration begins April 6th.
