43	1. Planning and Zoning Commission Meeting Minutes from January 11, 2023
44 45	Kevin Lyman asked for a motion for the January 11, 2023, Planning and Zoning Commission meeting minutes.
46 47	Paul Taylor made a motion to approve the January 11, 2023, Planning and Zoning Commission meeting minutes. Kam Valguardson seconded the motion. All members of the commission voted in favor. 3-0

50	Kevin Lyman asked for a motion to enter public hearing.

54	2a. Salem City Fire/EMS Building Property R-15 to P-F Zone Change

55 Walter Bird stated that Salem City is wanting to rezone parcel 30:0020:086 (approx. located at 750 N 56 250 E) from R-15 (residential) to P-F (public facilities). The purpose for the proposed zone change is to 57 allow a Fire/EMS Building to be constructed on parcel 30:0020:086. 58 59 2b. General Plan Amendment (Moderate Income Housing) 60 Walter Bird stated that the moderate income housing portion of the general plan needs to be adjusted 61 because of recent state law requirements. Walter Bird showed the current moderate income housing portion of the general plan. The only proposed adjustment is strategy 4. The current strategy 4 reads the 62 following, "Waive, or partially waive, impact fees for affordable housing". The proposed strategy 4 will 63 64 replace the current 4 strategy in the moderate-income housing portion of the general plan. The 65 proposed strategy 4 states the following, "Create moderate income housing for residents of the city that 66 are disabled or 55 years of age or older". Walter Bird mentioned that the proposed master planned 67 developments in Salem will help the City comply with the moderate-income housing regulations from 68 the state. 69 70 Kevin Lyman asked for a motion to close public hearing. 71 Kam Valguardson made a motion to close public hearing. Paul Taylor seconded the motion. All members 72 of the commission voted in favor. 3-0 73 74 3. Motion 75 76 3a. Salem City Fire/EMS Building Property R-15 to P-F Zone Change 77 Kevin Lyman asked for a motion for the Salem City Fire/EMS building property R-15 to P-F zone change. 78 Kam Valguardson made a motion to recommend approval of the Salem City Fire/EMS building property 79 R-15 to P-F zone change. Paul Taylor seconded the motion. All members of the commission voted in 80 favor. 3-0 81 82 **3b.** General Plan Amendment (Moderate Income Housing) 83 Kevin Lyman asked for a motion for the moderate-income housing general plan amendment. 84 Paul Taylor made a motion to recommend approval of the moderate-income housing general plan 85 amendment. Kam Valguardson seconded the motion. All members of the commission voted in favor. 3-0

3c. Site Plan – Tagg N Go Carwash (1009 N SR-198)

Bradey Wilde stated that the Tagg N Go Carwash site plan is located at 1009 N SR-198. Conner Atkin is present at tonight's meeting representing the Tagg N Go Carwash Site Plan. The proposed site plan meets all requirements of the C-1 zone. Bradey Wilde mentioned that the entire property will be cleaned up during the construction of the site plan. Bradey Wilde mentioned that the proposed site plan will be constructed on the north side of the property. There is potential for a commercial subdivision on the south side of the property. Bradey Wilde read the recommended conditions from DRC for the proposed site plan (refer to the 02/08/2023 DRC minutes). The DRC recommended approval of the Tagg N Go Carwash Site Plan with the recommended conditions. Kam Valguardson wanted to know how the sound from the blowers of the tunnel carwash and site plan lighting will be mitigated. It was mentioned that the blowers from the tunnel carwash will be facing SR-198 (the location of the blowers complies with the sound mitigation requirements for the tunnel carwashes in the C-1 zoning code). The lighting of the site plan will be contained on the site plan (the site plan meets the lighting requirements in the C-1 zoning code). Paul Taylor mentioned that the detention basin on the west side of the site plan will be a great buffer for the adjacent homes. Paul Taylor asked how many cars the carwash que can stack. Conner Atkin mentioned that the carwash que can stack 30 cars. Paul Taylor wanted to know how much water the carwash would use. Conner Atkin mentioned that the carwash uses around 30 gallons of water per carwash. Paul Taylor believes that an annual evaluation of the Tagg N Go Carwash water use should be performed.
