- The Parade route may be accessed online at www.salemcity.org, or is available upon request at the Salem Activity Center.
- Entries must be appropriate for a family audience. Participants must be dressed appropriately to enhance the theme of the entry and the parade.
- NO SEMI'S will be allowed in the parade.
- NO WATER SHOOTING entries will be allowed by parade entry participants - including water blasters, squirt guns, water balloons etc. Salem City may designate a water entry for the parade, this entry will be run by individuals approved by city officials.
- Parade participation and position are solely at the discretion of the Salem Days Executive Committee. Factors that may be considered are application return date and entry needs. Commercial and advertising entries will be strictly limited. Local entities will have preference over non-local entities. All floats will be accepted. If you are a business and would like to utilize the parade for advertising, you may want to consider a business float.
- Required: One person walking by each tire if the entry will be distributing candy.
- Nothing can be thrown from an entry - distribute only.
 - Any/all literature distributed along the parade route must be approved through the application process. Individuals, organizations or businesses not having an entry in the parade are prohibited from distributing literature along the parade route. Any/all literature approved for distribution **MUST** be distributed by participants walking along with an approved parade entry. No literature may be thrown, shot or dropped from the parade entry.
- The driver's sole role & responsibility is to drive the entry safely through the parade route. The driver may NOT throw, discard, spray, or distribute any sort of items while operating the vehicle.
- No person(s) will be allowed to sit in the back of a truck that is pulling a float or trailer.
- Person(s) may ride in the back of a truck, ONLY if the truck is NOT pulling a trailer or float. Individuals must remain in the back of the truck during the entire duration of the parade, and the tailgate MUST remain closed.
- There is to be NO jumping on or off floats or vehicles **WHILE THE FLOAT OR VEHICLES ARE IN MOTION** during the parade. No one is allowed to ride on running boards, hoods, or vehicle fenders.
- Alcohol is strictly prohibited on all entries.

- Adults responsible for floats with children cannot be late.
- Entries must be parade ready when you arrive.
- Limited parking - please carpool or arrange for drop-off.
- Once the parade has begun, participants may only enter/exit from the rear of the trailer/float/vehicle.
- **Horse entries responsible for their own clean up and must provide their own pooper scooper. An additional fee of \$25.00 will be charged for horse entries. If you arrive with a clean-up staff, you will be refunded \$25.00. Animals must be able to handle the stresses of the parade.**
- Do not create gaps in the parade line-up. If your dance group has a routine to perform it has to be designed to permit CONSTANT FORWARD MOVEMENT. Please be considerate of other participants and spectators!!
- Violation may be cause for removal from the parade.
Thank you for your cooperation.
- Please be staged by 9:15am - Loafer Complex and the LDS Church on Canal Road will be used for staging. Specific instructions will be sent to you by the parade chair.
- **NO UNLOADING at KNOLL PARK - Stopping in the road at the end of the parade route creates a hazard to all. PLEASE FOLLOW THE UNLOADING AND PARADE EXIT INSTRUCTIONS SENT TO YOU BY THE PARADE CHAIR.**
- Judging of entries will begin promptly at 9:15. Awards Mayor's Choice & Queen's Choice will be given.
- You will be contacted about parade information via phone by AUG 9th.

****If you plan to hand out paper advertisements, please make sure they are attached to something ie: a toothbrush, ball, or candy. The citizens along the parade route don't keep plain papers.**

We do not want loose papers littering our city roadways and pond.

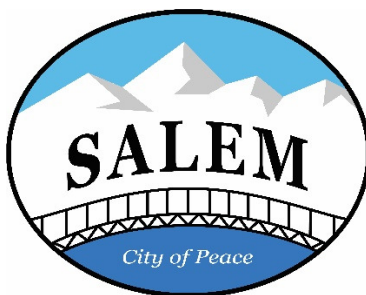

I, _____, The undersigned, representing entry or and in behalf of all participants of entry, intending to be legally bound, hereby for myself, my family, my heirs, executors, and administrators, and for and in behalf of all participants of this entry, their families, their heirs, their executors, and administrators, forever waiver, release and discharge any and all rights and claims for damages and causes of suit or action known or unknown, that may have against the State of Utah, the Department of Transportation, the Utah Transportation Commission, the Utah Highway Patrol, their officers, agents, and employees, and the City of Salem, their officers, agents, political entities, and employees, including all Committee persons, Officials, Volunteers, and all sponsors and their officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives, successors and assigns, for any and all injuries that may be suffered while participating in this event, **Salem Days 2023 parade, August 12, 2023**.
