STORM DRAIN : Acceptable Discharges (per Phase Two Permit)

The rule of thumb is; " If you don't drink it, don't dump it " but there are a few exceptions to what you can safely and legally discharge into a storm drain other than storm water;

- Lawn and landscaping irrigation runoff
- Foundation and footing drain flow
- Water from non-commercial car washing
- Water main flushing
- Diverted stream flows
- Pumped ground water
- Air conditioning condensate
- Water from crawl space pumps
- Residual street washing waters
- Discharges from potable water sources
- Residential, de-chlorinated pool discharges
- Flows from emergency firefighting activities
