MODERATE INCOME HOUSING

Jason explained the State requires every city to have an affordable housing element to their General Plan. The State gets in numbers for the population and median household income then the cities need to come up with an action plan. Jason went through the proposed moderate income housing section along with the action the City is taking and plans to take.

The DRC had recommended a couple of things like removing the large trees from the intersection of 640 N. and SR 198; adding a grease trap; adding outside lighting and addressing the traffic flow for the two drive thru windows. They had submitted an updated plan addressing these issues.
