The Central Utah Water Conservancy District, the Department of the Interior-CUPCA Office, and the Utah Reclamation Mitigation and Conservation Commission, as Joint Lead Agencies (JLAs), are evaluating a proposed realignment of a portion of the South Fields Reach of the Spanish Fork – Santaquin Pipeline, which is a 60-inch welded steel pipe, that is part of the Utah Lake Drainage Basin System of the Central Utah Project. The Spanish Fork – Santaquin Pipeline was evaluated in an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and Records of Decision completed in 2004/2005. The South Fields Reach is located in unincorporated Utah County between the cities of Spanish Fork and Salem and begins with its connection to the Spanish Fork Reach (just south of Powerhouse Road in Spanish Fork) and ends at the Woodland Hills Drive/Salem Canal Road intersection. The JLAs are preparing an Environmental Assessment to evaluate potential impacts associated with the proposed realignment. The JLAs are soliciting comments from the public and agencies and are holding an Open House on **Wednesday, September 20th between 6-7:30 PM** to present the proposed realignment. The Open House will be held at Foothills Elementary School located at 412 South 810 East in Salem. For a complete project description and how to comment on the proposed project go to southfields.cuwcd.com. Hooray for back to school! Make sure you're your child is doing their very best in school to be successful later on in their life by scheduling them an eye exam. Every 1 in 4 elementary school age child has a form of vision impairment that can affect their ability to learn if they have a hard time seeing the board or other materials. There are about 2,000 elementary school age children in Salem, so if 1 in 4 of them have a vision impairment, that means that 500 children in Salem struggle with vision! It is recommended that a child should have an annual exam every 2 years.

Here are some helpful ways to detect vision problems in a child as a parent:

Avoiding reading

Short attention span

Difficulty with catching a ball, copying information from a board, tying their shoes

Holding book close to face when reading

Lots of blinking and eye rubbing



Vision is not just the ability to see clearly or having 20/20 eyesight, but it is also the ability to recognize, comprehend, and remember.

Remember, a child cannot explain that they have a vision problem because they don't know otherwise. Since they don't know what it is like to see properly, do not leave their eye health up to them. Your schoolwide vision screenings can only do part of the work for catching these impairments within a child, take the next step and take the to a professional to get a full comprehensive eye exam.
