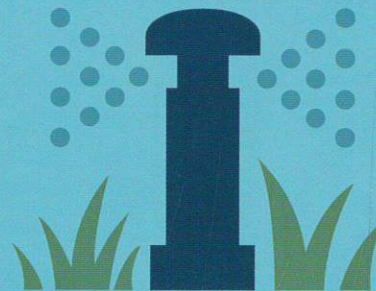


Landscape Irrigation in Utah

1.5x more water is used on landscapes than indoors

(40% is used indoors and 60% is used outdoors)



If you watered your lawn one day less each week, you could reduce your water consumption by

10-15%

Remember to turn off your sprinkler system on rainy days.

Recommended Turfgrass Watering Schedule for Utah

	NORTHERN AND CENTRAL UTAH	WASHINGTON COUNTY
STARTUP—APRIL 30	Every 6 days if needed	Every 5 days if needed
MAY	Every 4 days	Every 4 days
JUNE	Every 3 days	Every 3 days
JULY	Every 2 days	Every 2 days
AUGUST	Every 3 days	Every 3 days
SEPTEMBER	Every 6 days	Every 5 days
OCTOBER—SHUTDOWN	Every 10 days if needed	Every 7 days if needed
NOVEMBER—SHUTDOWN	--	Every 10 days if needed

Apply 1/2 inch of water each time you irrigate turfgrass (3/4 inch in Washington County).
