The Sewing Circle- ADULT BEYOND the Beginning Garments

This class is designed to be a "BEYOND the BEGINNING" Adult/confident Teen class.

This is a garment class. We will focus on stable fabric "TOPS" in this class - shirts, dresses.... (no stretch)

You must have some basic sewing knowledge and be comfortable doing some sewing homework. It is designed to help you start a garment from a pattern. With the lack of the "Big 4 pattern companies: Vogue, Simplicity, Butterick & McCalls", finding the correct pattern and getting it printed will take some extra steps. However, we have a few patterns available here in the store to choose from.

Some patterns may need to be printed once purchased from the internet. This may require taking a file to a printer that has access to AO sized paper (very large). Some mail & copy stores are cheaper when printing the pattern. Instructions can usually be printed on a traditional printer.

AGENDA:

- Meet with Melissa at least 1 week prior to class to select a pattern and supplies. This is important so that you start the class with the proper supplies.
 - Supplies needed:
 - Sewing machine in good working order
 - Proper thread type and weight
 - Threaded bobbin
 - Pattern selection
 - Pattern printing if needed
 - Pattern ease (for making custom sized pattern)
 - Proper fabric and amount of fabric
 - Interfacing or stabilizer needed
 - Proper needle type and size
 - Iron, best press & pressing surface
 - Scissors (large to cut fabric, small to cut threads as you sew)
 - Pins
 - Tape measure
 - Chalk pencil or frixion pen
 - Pressing cloth (we will discuss Teflon pressing mat works great)
 - Hand needles
 - Buttons (if needed)
 - Zipper (if needed)
 - Notebook and Pen for taking notes

• Meeting #1:

- Taking measurements
- Tracing your pattern onto pattern ease for the PROPER size adjustments
- Laying out the fabric and pattern
- Cutting the fabric and any stabilizers required
- Finishing raw edges instruction and practice
- Homework: Read beginning of pattern to find out seam allowance, order of construction and any construction tips. Test sewing machine and your seam allowance on scrap fabric.

- Stay-stitching and finishing the fabric edges
- Easing
- Pressing/ironing
- Assembly instructions review each
