You will be working with the following concepts:

- Design Positioning
- Advanced Appliqué techniques
- Advanced quilting techniques
- If you have a Viking: Design Applique stitch
- If you have a Pfaff, advanced ribbon stitch & stacking stitches

This is a workshop to cover these techniques ONLY. Bring the following supplies to practice these techniques and you will be able to use them in a quilt or wall banner like one of these shown.

Your mid-sized hoop

- two layers of a plain, light colored fabric and a piece of batting to fit in between (see quilting detail in second picture)
- 3 scraps of fabric for trunks (large enough to practice with) and matching decorative thread
- 1 scrap of fabric about 8" for variety of other appliqués and matching threads
- 1 piece of fusible web your choice (steam-a-seam light or soft-fuse)
- 6 pieces of scrap fabric about 6" x 6" to make the flower and aqua magic stabilizer to fit the hoop, thread to match (see picture of flowers)
- 1 piece of scrap solid color fabric for 1 flag sample with matching thread
