

Commissioner Meeting  
August 13, 2018

Chairman Ben Fox called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Paul Hodge, Chuck Spradlin, Kathy Robison County Clerk, and County Counselor Paul Dean.

No commission meeting minutes

Road and Bridge Administrative Assistant Amber Woodie reported that crews are starting the bridge project on 380<sup>th</sup>, northwest of Madison today, that's where Interim Road and Bridge Supervisor Darrell Crisman is on site. The large I-beam they ordered is supposed to be in later that day. Zack Marshall is there, and they are digging for the pad, and will build forms at the shop, then they will be able to pour the landings. Woodie reported a wood-top bridge was repaired on 155<sup>th</sup>, east of Neal, near AA and BB roads. Ditch work and a culvert was replaced at W40, northwest of Fall River Lake. Crews have been doing some patching on the cemetery roads, getting ready for the chip/seal project. Woodie reported that Crisman has been in contact with the manufacturer of the chip/spreader, and was told by a representative "there is no reason it is working the way it is". The rep said he would do some research on the problem and get back with Crisman. Crisman would like to run the bomag on the Reece Road to give it a good base. Woodie told commissioners that Bettis, a company that does chip/seal projects looked at the rodeo arena area, and will hopefully be giving us a bid soon. Woodie said the project would likely not begin until this fall. Woodie presented a petition for a company installing fiber optic cable in the Fall River area, parallel with a county road. The commissioners approved of it.

Commissioners viewed the weekly Treasurer's Report.

Commissioner Spradlin made a motion to approve payroll in the amount of \$91,406.42. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Spradlin made a motion to approve payroll in the amount of \$340,410.03. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Spradlin made a motion to approve an employment verification for Arianna Mock, current Health Department employee, to the Sheriff Department Dispatch, effective August 13<sup>th</sup>. Her rate of pay at the Sheriff's Department will be \$11.00 per hour. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried. She will be replacing Timothy Dimick.

Commissioner Fox made a motion to approve an employment verification for Douglass Stewart to work in the jail. His rate of pay at the Sheriff's Department will be \$10.00 per hour, effective August 8<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Spradlin seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Scott Day, with Day Insurance Solutions in Topeka, provided commissioners with various health insurance quotes for county employees, outside of the county's current state-contract health insurance. Various providers, including Blue Cross Blue Shield, were quoted. Commissioners made no decisions, and planned to review the proposals.

Commissioner Fox made a motion for a 5 minute executive session with Emergency Management/Noxious Weed Director Levi Vinson, Undersheriff Randy Cox, and County Counselor Paul Dean. Commissioner Spradlin seconded the motion. The motion carried.

No decision was made.


At 9:55 a.m. Commissioner Fox made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Spradlin seconded the motion. The motion carried.


The commissioners held a Board of Canvassing following the meeting.


The commissioners were also going to view a road at 160<sup>th</sup> (Perkins) @ 11:30 a.m.


