Greenwood County Landfill

Greenwood County offers a functioning landfill for the disposal of Construction and Demolition debris. This landfill is available to all residents and businesses in Greenwood County and open to any contractors with job sites within county lines.

Hours of Operation

Monday: 8:00 a.m. to noon Wednesday: 8:00 to noon Friday and second Saturday of each month: 8:00 to 3:00 p.m. **Hours are subject to weather** Closed for all major Holidays

There is a \$15 minimum dumping fee, increasing by \$15 for every ton after the first ton.

Accepted Items

- Any construction and demolition debris
- Demolished or burnt down buildings (Insulation, paneling, shingles, siding, drywall, etc.)

No Charge Items Accepted

- White Goods (Hot water heaters, washers, dryers, refrigerators/freezers, air conditioners (As long as Freon is removed before dumping)
- Furniture (Mattresses, tables, chairs, dressers, end tables, cabinets, etc.)[Business will be CHARGED]

Items NOT Accepted

- Tires
- Processed (treated wood)
- Bagged or large quantities of leaves and/or grass clippings
- Plastic

- Clean concrete, brush, and asphalt rubble (Must be clean, NO REBAR)
- Trees & Brush
- Metal Wire
- Fiberglass
- Chemical or Aerosol containers
- Mobile Homes
- Telephone Poles

Dumpsters at County Shop – Household Trash

The Greenwood County Road and Bridge Department offer four large dumpsters at the County Shop to dispose of any municipal household trash. These dumpsters are available for all Greenwood County residents Monday through Thursday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Fridays from 8:00 a.m. to noon. It cost a minimum of \$3 to dump, with the prices increasing as the size of load increases. Payment can only be made in cash or check.

Items Accepted in the Dumpsters

- TVs, computers and small appliances
- Burn Barrels
- Household Trash / Garbage
- Small appliances
- Clothing
- Windshield Glass (as long as they are broken and not whole)
- Tires **Must NOT be placed in the dumpers, and have a separate fee per each tire**

Directions from Eureka – Landfill signs will help guide you

Head east on HWY 54 out of Eureka to the South 99 HWY intersection – approximately 2 miles

Turn right, headed south on S 99 HWY, continue south for approximately 1.5 miles

Turn left, headed east on County Street 130

Continue on 130 street for approximately 5 miles

At the T intersection turn left, headed north on County Road X

Continue on County Road X for approximately 1.5 miles

County Road X leads you straight into the County Landfill
