

Commissioner Meeting
October 3, 2016

Chairman Brian Hind called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Ben Fox, Cole Conard and Kathy Robison, County Clerk. Paul Dean, County Counselor was not present.

Commissioner Fox made a motion to approve September 26, 2016 minutes. Commissioner Conard seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Roger Lowe, Road and Bridge Supervisor, reported that they got the chip/seal done on the south end of the county; crews are still working on damages from the last storm; discussed mowing; Lowe asked about the bridge on W Rd. and Levi Vinson, Emergency Management Director said that FEMA quoted \$25,000 for the bridge approach repairs; Lowe reported he has been working with Levi on the FEMA reports; Lowe reported he replaced a tinhorn on U road; Lowe discussed a few bridges that have debris. Commissioner Hind mentioned a bridge on road Z or AA between 330 and 320 that is plugged underneath. Commissioner Fox reported he received a call from a constituent that was very happy with the chip/seal.

Dale Kirkham invited the commissioners to participate in the Cattleman's Day parade on November 5th, as well as any of the other events. Kirkham also asked for approval to hold kids games on the courthouse lawn. The commissioners approved.

Commissioner Hind made a motion for a 10 minute executive session for personnel with Levi Vinson, Emergency Management Director and Roger Lowe, Road and Bridge Director. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

No decision was made.

4-H Members, of the Fancy Mustang Club, Jonathan Turner, Reese Greenwood, Caylee Baker, and Shelby Welsh spoke to the commissioners about their favorite projects and presented them with an apple pie made by Greenwood to promote 4-H Week and express their appreciation for the county's support.

The commissioners reviewed the weekly Treasurer's Report.

Commissioner Fox made a motion to approve the Fee Reports. Commissioner Hind seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Fox made a motion to approve payables in the amount of \$7,874.36. Commissioner Hind seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Kathy Robison, County Clerk, told the commissioners it's time for the Pitney Bowes lease agreement to be renewed. Robison was contacted by Kenneth Rohr, Pitney Bowes Major Account Manager, who sent her a lease agreement and an email stating that with the new agreement our monthly payment would be lowered to \$343.04 a month. This would save \$86 per month from our current monthly payment of \$429. Commissioner Conard made a motion to approve the three-year lease agreement with Pitney Bowes. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Conard made a motion to approve appointing Nancy Mock as the Housing Commissioner for Greenwood County for a term of four years. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Sheriff Heath Samuels, representing the Greenwood County Long-Term Recovery Committee, asked the commissioners to open the landfill on the afternoon of Saturday, October 15 for a tornado cleanup day in Eureka. Samuels reported there are around eight properties that have been torn down recently and need to be cleaned up and that a team of volunteers and several dump trucks will be available that day. The commissioners approve the request and agreed to waive the tipping fees for the day as well.

The next commission meeting will be Tuesday, October 11th, because the courthouse will be closed Monday in observance of the Columbus Holiday.

South Salem Township Fire Building open house is tonight.

Commissioner Hind made a motion for a 5 minute executive session for personnel with Dalton Evenson, Noxious Weed Director. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

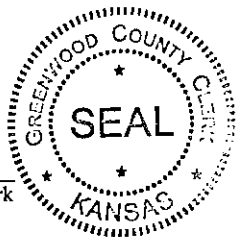
No decision was made.
