Candle Mat in the Hoop

Candle Mat in 360 mm x 260 mm hoop







Approx size: 9 3/4" square

Approx size: 7¾" square

In our class this month (November) we will explore and review the top features within our amazing Husqvarna Viking sewing and embroidery machine. We will create and stitch out the candle mat in our embroidery hoop using an embroidery design from our machine. The Design Shaping feature will be used to duplicate and evenly place our Christmas designs in a circle shape. The Design Applique feature will be used to attach the backing to the candle mat in the hoop. We will be creating multiple designs but only stitching out one design in class. This project adds an elegant touch to our holiday table and will look spectacular with a candle, candy dish, or a vase of flowers gracing the center of the mat.

## **Supply List**

Husqvarna Viking Sewing and Embroidery Machine, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord, Single Hole Stitch Plate, Sensor Q foot, 360 x 260 hoop and for the DS 85 machine owners: the 260 mm x 200 mm hoop.

HV ® Topstitch needle, size 80 or Quilting needle, size 75 (Available for purchase at Patty's)

40 wt. Embroidery Thread. The Christmas bell designs uses 2 shades of green, a red, two shades of yellow/gold, and a black thread. The Christmas Garland design uses 4 different shades of green thread; a pale-yellow thread for the berries on the mistletoe and a red thread.

The following thread colors are provided to guide you in selecting your threads – you can use any brand of good quality embroidery thread and any colors that appeal to you – you do not have to use the same colors in the sampler book.

For the Christmas bells: RA 2457, Green Dust; RA 2595, Sage; RA 2263, Foxy Red; RA 2461, Wheat; RA 2464, Nectar and RA 2296, Black.

For the garland wreath: RA 2252, Ivy; RA 2545, Cypress; RA 2595, Sage; RA 2392, Harbor Green; RA 2557, Pale Yellow and RA 2263, Foxy Red.

1 spool of 40 wt. Embroidery thread or 50/ wt. Sewing thread to match the background fabric.

**Embroidery Bobbin Thread** 

Background fabric for design and backing: Cut (1) 12"x 12" and (1) 13" x 13" for the 360 x 260 hoop. Designer Sapphire machines: Cut (1) 10" x 10" and (1) 11" x 11".

Fusible Woven Interfacing (such as Pellon Shape Flex SF 101): Cut (2) 11 ½" x 11 ½" for 360 x 260 hoop **or** for Designer Sapphire machines: cut (2) 9 ½" x 9 ½" for 260 x 200 hoop). Center this over and fuse to the back of both pieces of background fabric.

Fusible Fleece (such as Pellon Fusible Fleece 987F): Cut (1) 10" x 10" and cut (1) 7 3/4" x 7 3/4" (this smaller piece will be used in final construction) **or** for Designer Sapphire 85 machines: cut (1) 8" x 8" and (1) 6" x 6" (this smaller piece will be used in final construction).

Heavy Weight Cut Away Stabilizer: Large enough to hoop in the 360 x 260 hoop or the 260 x 200 hoop. It will be hooped for the project. After the embroidery is complete, this will be trimmed and left in the project. It is not the No-Show Fusible Mesh Cut Away stabilizer or tear away stabilizer but a heavier cut away stabilizer available for purchase by the yard at Patty's

8" or 10" long strip of 1/4" double stick fusible web tape

Scissors (to trim fusible fleece along seam line) or Trimmer by George with 60 mm rotary cutter

Clover's Fabric Folding Pen

Point Turning Tool

12" ruler with rotary cutter

**General Sewing Supplies and Tools:** such as Pins, Snips, Scissors, Seam Ripper, Rotary Cutter with sharp blade; non-permanent fabric marking pen, Rulers to mark fabric and stabilizer, to include 18" long ruler, etc.

<u>Prep for class:</u> Starch the background & the backing fabric. Fuse the fusible woven interfacing to the back of **both** pieces & then fuse the **larger** piece of fusible fleece to the back of the **smaller piece of background fabric** with the fused woven interfacing.
